EXTENSION ORDER

The law judge issued an initial decision in this matter on June 5, 2009.¹ No petition for review was filed by respondent Gordon Brent Pierce and the Commission did not choose to review the initial decision on its own initiative. Subsequently, on July 8, 2009, the Commission issued a notice that the initial decision had become final as to Pierce.²

The Division of Enforcement has requested an extension of time, until July 29, 2015, to file an opposition to Pierce's recently filed Motion to Vacate the Commission's Order. The Division represents that Pierce consents to this request. Under the circumstances, it appears appropriate to grant the requested extension. Therefore,

It is ORDERED that the time for the Division to respond to the Motion is extended to and including July 29, 2015.
