NOTICE THAT INITIAL DECISION HAS BECOME FINAL

The time for filing a petition for review of the initial decision in this proceeding has expired. No such petition has been filed by Disaster Preparedness Systems, Inc., Electric Moto Corp., or EMO Corp. and the Commission has not chosen to review the decision on its own initiative.

Accordingly, notice is hereby given, pursuant to Rule 360(d) of the Commission's Rules of Practice,¹ that the initial decision of the administrative law judge has become the final decision of the Commission with respect to Disaster Preparedness Systems, Inc., Electric Moto Corp., and EMO Corp.² The order contained in that decision is hereby declared effective.
