ORDER GRANTING MOTION  
TO EXTEND TIME TO FILE  
BRIEFS

Respondent filed a Petition for Review in this matter on February 21, 2017, and on March 15, 2017, the Commission issued an order granting Respondent's petition for review and scheduling briefs. Respondent was ordered to file a brief in support of his petition for review ("brief in support") by April 14, 2017.<sup>1</sup> Respondent filed a motion on April 12, 2017, pursuant to Rule 161(a), requesting a 30-day extension of time to file the brief in support and an equal extension of time for the Division's opposition, and Respondent's reply, if any.

Extensions of time are disfavored. However, given the reasons set forth in Respondent's motion, including that Respondent is *pro se* and incarcerated, it appears appropriate to extend the time for filing a brief in support by 14 days from April 14, 2017, and the time for filing a reply brief, if any, by an additional week.
