Respondent Eagletech Communications, Inc., has requested issuance of an amended subpoena duces tecum. At issue is the production of documents created between January 1 and December 31, 2000, by an organization that is not a party to this proceeding. The Division of Enforcement (Division) opposes the request.

I agree with the Division that the request seeks information that is not relevant to this proceeding or reasonably calculated to lead to the discovery of relevant evidence. Pursuant to Rule 232(b) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, I deny the requested subpoena on the grounds that it is unreasonable, oppressive, excessive in scope, and unduly burdensome.
