

**JOINT MOTION TO STAY PROCEEDINGS,
WITH SUPPORTING POINTS AND AUTHORITIES**

The Commission issued an Order Instituting Public Administrative Proceedings and Imposing Temporary Suspension Pursuant to Rule 102(e)(3)(i)(A) of the Commission's Rules of Practice against respondent Robert C. Weaver, Jr. on November 12, 2014. The Commission denied respondent's motion to lift the temporary suspension on December 29, 2014, and ordered that this matter be set down for a public hearing. During a prehearing conference on January 16, 2015, the Chief Administrative Law Judge determined that this matter would be resolved on summary disposition, and set the following schedule: the Office of the General Counsel's (OGC's) Motion for Summary Disposition is due March 9, 2015; the Respondent's Opposition is due April 16, 2015; and OGC's Reply is due April 30, 2015.

The parties have now agreed in principle to a settlement on all major terms, and OGC expects to receive a signed Offer of Settlement shortly. Therefore, pursuant to Rule 161(c)(2) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, the parties respectfully submit this joint request that the Chief Administrative Law Judge enter an order staying further proceedings in this matter


pending the Commission's decision on the Respondent's Offer of Settlement. The parties understand that the requested stay is contingent upon:

(A) Respondent submitting to the Commission staff, within 15 business days of the stay, a signed offer of settlement in conformance with Rule 240; and

(B) within 20 business days of receipt of the signed offer, the staff submitting the settlement offer and accompanying recommendation to the Commission for consideration.

Id. If the parties fail to meet either of these deadlines or if the Commission rejects the offer of settlement, the parties will promptly so notify the hearing officer. *Id.*
