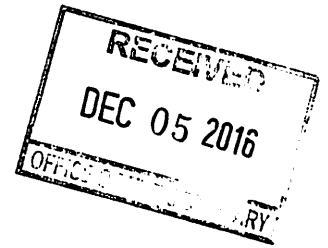

UNOPPOSED REQUEST FOR ADJOURNMENT

Respondent MED-X, Inc., through its undersigned counsel, and pursuant to Rule 161 of the Rules of Practice of the United States Securities and Exchange Commission, 17 C.F.R. § 201.161, respectfully requests that the dates set forth in the Scheduling Order dated October 27, 2016 (the "Scheduling Order") be extended by thirty-five days, or such period as is convenient for this Court, starting with the exchange and filing of witness and exhibit lists currently set for November 30, 2016. Counsel for the Division of Enforcement does not oppose this request.

The grounds for this request are as follows:

- (a) The undersigned served his notice of appearance on November 28, 2016 after it became apparent that prior counsel for Respondent may be required to testify as a witness at the hearing;
- (b) Prior counsel's withdrawal is effective as of December 1, 2016;

(c) Given the deadlines set forth in the Scheduling Order, Respondent will be substantially prejudiced in presenting its case absent an extension to allow new counsel to adequately prepare;


(d) The brief extension will not unduly delay this proceeding, which was commenced by order of the Securities and Exchange Commission dated October 13, 2016;

(e) None of the parties previously has sought an adjournment or extension;
and

(f) A 35-day extension, or such period as is convenient for this Court, is appropriate in light of the intervening holidays and to avoid disruptions to the pre-existing commitments of the parties, witnesses and counsel.


