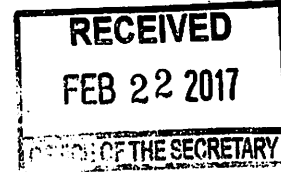

JOINT MOTION TO APPOINT SETTLEMENT ADMINISTRATIVE LAW JUDGE

Pursuant to this Court's Scheduling and General Prehearing Order dated December 29, 2016 (the "Order"), the Division of Enforcement and Respondent Adrian Beamish (collectively "the Parties") jointly move the Court to appoint an Administrative Law Judge ("Settlement ALJ") to mediate a settlement conference. The Parties stipulate as follows:

(1) The Parties are willing to participate in good faith in a confidential settlement process.

(2) The Parties' representations and submissions, including any statement made by any party, attorney or other participant, are confidential. Any such representation or submission will not be construed as an admission against interest and may not be used in court in connection with this case or any other litigation.

(3) The Settlement ALJ will not discuss any representations or submissions of the Parties with this Court.

(4) Communications with the Settlement ALJ, including any submissions to him or her, will be not be part of this case's record.

(5) As required by the Court's Order, for purposes of the settlement conference, the Parties waive: (a) the right to claim bias or prejudgment by the Court or the Settlement ALJ based on any views expressed during the settlement process; (b) the right to a public proceeding (because the settlement process will not be open to the public); (c) the right to a proceeding on the record (because the settlement process will not be recorded stenographically); and (d) the right to an *inter partes* proceeding (because the settlement ALJ may confer with the parties *ex parte*).
