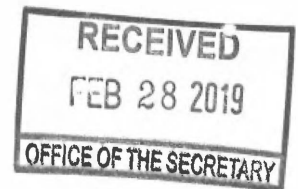

**DIVISION OF ENFORCEMENT'S MOTION
FOR SERVICE BY PUBLICATION AND BRIEF IN SUPPORT**

I. Motion

The Division of Enforcement (“Division”) hereby asks the Court to recognize and ratify the publication of the Orders Instituting Proceedings (“OIPs) on the Commission’s website as an adequate means of service on Respondents China Linen Textile Industry Ltd. (CIK No. 1336655) (Ticker Symbol CTXIF) (“CTXIF”) and Huixin Waste Water Solutions, Inc. (CIK No. 1381807) (Former Ticker Symbol HXWWF) (“HXWWF”) (collectively the “Respondents”). The Division attempted service the Orders Instituting Proceedings (“OIPs”) on the Respondents pursuant to the Hague Convention on the Service Abroad of Judicial and Extrajudicial Documents in Civil or Commercial Matters (the “Hague Convention”), 20 U.S.T. 361, T.I.A.S. 6638, 658 U.N.T.A. 163 (1964), by delivering, in separate requests, copies of the Orders Instituting Proceedings (“OIPs”) to China’s Hague Convention authority, the Chinese Ministry of Justice (“MOJ”), over a year ago.

As explained below, the Division believes that the Commission's publication of the OIP and of our Motion on the Commission's website constitutes an adequate means of service by publication and in fact is, at least in this case, superior to publication in a newspaper, and we ask the Court to recognize it as such. Alternatively, the Division would like to use one legal notice of the OIPs addressed to both respondents to be published in the *International New York Times* due to the high cost of publishing the legal notice.

II. Statement of Facts

On October 23, 2017, OIA sent the Form USM-94 including documents for service on HXWWF to the MOJ via UPS. On October 26, 2017, UPS delivered it to the MOJ. Frye Decl. Exs. 1-3.

On March 31, 2017, OIA sent a Form USM-94 including documents for service on CTXIF. On April 6, 2017, UPS delivered the package to the MOJ. Frye Decl. Exs. 4-6.

As shown in the Frye Decl., we have contacted the MOJ several times for updates on the status of our service requests for the Respondents. We have yet to receive returns of service for either of the Respondents and have no idea when they will be completed.

Both CTXIF and HXWWF were Cayman Islands corporations. The Registrar of Corporations ("Registrar") struck CTXIF's from the register of companies on January 30, 2015 and had no registered office. Frye Decl. Ex. 7. The Registrar struck HXWWF off the register of companies on October 31, 2016. Frye Decl. Ex. 8. We attempted to serve HXWWF's registered office in the Cayman Islands, but that service was unsuccessful.

In addition to the foregoing, as the Court is aware, the Commission maintains a website at www.sec.gov. Between March 21, 2017 and March 17, 2018, 4,939,404 sessions on www.sec.gov originated in China, or 4.93% of the total web sessions on www.sec.gov. Frye

Decl. Ex. 9. The Commission published English versions of both OIPs on its website, at <https://www.sec.gov/litigation/admin/2017/34-80293.pdf> for CTXIF and at <https://www.sec.gov/litigation/admin/2017/34-81647.pdf> for HXWWF, in each case on the date of issuance. As shown in the Declaration of David S. Frye in Support of the Division of Enforcement’s Motion for Service by Publication (“Frye Decl.”), the CTXIF OIP was the subject of 2,029 unique page views on the Commission’s website between March 21, 2017 and September 20, 2017. Frye Decl. Ex. 10. The HXWWF OIP was the subject of 1,906 unique pageviews between September 18, 2017 and March 17, 2018. Frye Decl. Ex. 11. In both cases, a large portion of the views came in the first month after institution. *Id.*

Simultaneously with the institution of each proceeding, the Commission suspended trading in the securities of CTXIF (see <https://www.sec.gov/litigation/suspensions/2017/34-80292.pdf>) and HXWWF (see <https://www.sec.gov/litigation/suspensions/2017/34-81648.pdf>).

The Division also contacted former counsel for each respondent. We obtained email addresses for officers of each company, which we believe to be valid, but were advised by OIA that the Commission cannot use email service for China.

III. Argument

The Commission’s Rules of Practice provide several alternative means of serving respondents in foreign countries, including the following:

Upon persons in a foreign country. Notice of a proceeding to a person in a foreign country may be made by **any of the following methods**:

. . .

(C) Any method **that is reasonably calculated to give notice**:

- (1) As prescribed by the foreign country’s law for service in that country in an action in its courts of general jurisdiction: or

- (2) As the foreign authority directs in response to a letter rogatory or letter of request: or
 - (3) Unless prohibited by the foreign country's law, by delivery a copy of the order instituting proceedings to the individual personally, or using any form of mail that the Secretary or the interested division addresses and sends to the individual and that requires a signed receipt; or
- (D) **By any other means not prohibited by international agreement, as the Commission or hearing officer orders.**

Rule of Practice 141(a)(2)(iv)(C) and (D) (Italics in the original – emphasis in bold added).

Notably, the plain language of this rule makes clear that these are independent, not sequential, means of service. In other words, the Division is not required to exhaust all other means of service or prove that other forms of service are impossible before seeking to use any particular means of service. *Accord. Centreinvest, Inc.*, A.P. File No. 3-13304, <https://www.sec.gov/alj/aljorders/2009/3-13304.pdf> (Order Denying Motions for Reconsideration (Feb. 5, 2009) at 3.) (citations omitted.)

Notably, China's domestic law allows service by publication. The Civil Procedure Law of the People's Republic of China (adopted by the National People's Congress on April 9, 1992, last revised August 31, 2012), Article 92, provides: "If the whereabouts of the person on whom the litigation documents are to be served is unknown, or if the documents cannot be served by the other methods specified in this Section, the documents shall be served by public announcement. Sixty (60) days after the date of making a public announcement, the documents shall be deemed to have been served. The reasons for service by public announcement and the process gone through shall be recorded in the case files."¹

¹ This English translation was obtained by the Division on May 15, 2018 from Ms. Laney Zhang, Foreign Law Specialist (China), Law Library of Congress. Frye Decl. Ex. 12.

In *Duoyuan Printing, Inc.*, 2014 SEC LEXIS 2691 (July 28, 2014), after the Division was unsuccessful in getting a certificate of service from the Chinese MOJ for service of an OIP seeking relief under Exchange Act Section 12(j) against a delinquent issuer located in China, Chief Judge Murray approved the service of the OIP by notice of publication in China, specifically by a notice in the *International New York Times* once a week for four consecutive weeks. Commission ALJs have allowed similar service by publication in other foreign countries. See *Ceyoniq AG*, 2016 SEC LEXIS 3048 (Aug. 26, 2016) (service in Germany); *Alan Smith*, 2013 SEC LEXIS 3648 (Nov. 20, 2013) (service in Latvia); *Gregory D. Tindall*, 2012 SEC LEXIS 1892 (June 20, 2012) (service in Canada); and *Brokat Technologies Aktiengesellschaft*, 2011 SEC LEXIS 157 (Jan. 14, 2011) (service in Germany).

Additionally, federal courts have regularly authorized service by publication, finding that it is reasonably calculated to provide notice and that it complies with due process requirements. *SEC v. Tome*, 833 F.2d 1086, 1094 (2d Cir. 1987) (“Publication of the complaint and summons in the International Herald Tribune was ‘reasonably calculated’ to notify the [defendants].”); *SEC v. Anticevic*, No. 05-cv-6991, 2009 WL 361739, at *4 (S.D.N.Y. Feb 13, 2009) (“Plaintiff has reasonably calculated that publication of service in the three proposed newspapers will apprise [defendant] of the pendency of this action.”); *U.S. v. Shehyn*, 04-cv-2003, 2008 WL 6150322, at *3 (S.D.N.Y. Nov. 26, 2008) (“Service on a defendant in a foreign country by publication of a summons and complaint in the International Herald Tribune once a week for four successive weeks is permissible under Rule 4(f)(3) and comports with notions of due process.”)

Although exhaustion of other means of service is not required, we believe that our efforts to pursue them establishes our due diligence and leaves service by publication as the only option.

The MOJ has not completed our requests for service, but given the status of the companies, and our recent experience with service on delinquent issuers via the MOJ, we seriously doubt that such service will be successful.

As previously noted, the English versions of the OIPs were available worldwide via the Commission's website and within a month of institution of each proceeding were viewed hundreds of times on the Commission's webpage. It is significant to note that for both Respondents, trading suspensions issued simultaneously with the OIPs, which is likely responsible for attracting additional attention to the proceedings, and most especially from the Respondents' officers. We daresay that, should the Court not allow us to rely on web publication, the proposed *International New York Times* notice discussed below, four advertisements in a publication which we have no guarantee that the Respondents even read, much less subscribe to, will be hard-pressed to attract as much interest as the original postings on www.sec.gov, amplified by the trading suspensions, already have. On this basis, and on the facts herein, we believe that publication via the Commission's website provided adequate notice to the Respondents. At least one court has recognized internet publication as a valid means of service. *Microsoft Corp. v. Doe*, 2012 U.S. Dist. LEXIS 162122 (November 13, 2012 E.D.N.Y.) (service by email and internet publication)

Should the Court not recognize service by web publication, we submit that publishing notice in the *International New York Times* has been recognized by courts as being reasonably calculated to provide adequate notice to the Respondents. The *International New York Times* (formerly known as the *International Herald Tribune*) is an English-language newspaper of general circulation throughout the world, including China. It is an accepted means of publication

of a notice of a pending action under Fed.R.Civ.P. 4(f)(3). *See, e.g., SEC v. Tome*, 833 F.2d at 1091.

Service of notice of the Division's motion on CTXIF and HXWWF is suitable in this case because other methods of service are impractical. Service by mail is prohibited by China in its objection to Article 10(a) of the Hague Convention. Service by email, which is available for some countries, is not an option here. Service via the Hague Convention through the Chinese MOJ has proven to be impractical and unsuccessful in obtaining service of the OIP on Huixin within six months.

The Division proposes that the Court approve its publication of the attached Legal Notice in the *International New York Times* in China for once a week for four weeks. Frye Decl., Ex. 13. The Legal Notice names CTXIF and HXWWF, explains the allegations in the OIPs, and provides them with weblinks where they can download, free of charge, copies of the OIPs. We are also mailing notice copies of this motion to the last filing addresses of the respondents and for CTXIF, to another address we believe may be valid.

IV. Conclusion

For the reasons set forth above, the Division respectfully requests that the ALJ grant the Division's Motions for Service by Publication and ratify publication on the Commission's website as providing adequate notice to the Respondents. Alternatively, we request leave to serve by publication through a notice in the *International New York Times* for four weeks in the form provided in Frye Decl. Ex. 13.

**DECLARATION OF DAVID S. FRYE IN SUPPORT OF
DIVISION OF ENFORCEMENT'S MOTION FOR SERVICE BY PUBLICATION**

DAVID S. FRYE, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, declares:

1. I am a Senior Counsel with the Division of Enforcement (“Division”) of the Securities and Exchange Commission (“Commission”), and co-counsel for the Division in the captioned administrative proceedings. I submit this Declaration in support of the Division’s Motion for Service by Publication against China Linen Textile Industry Ltd. (CIK No. 1336655) (Ticker Symbol CTXIF) (“CTXIF”) and Huixin Waste Water Solutions, Inc. (CIK No. 1381807) (Former Ticker Symbol HXWWF) (“HXWWF”) (collectively the “Respondents”).

2. Attached hereto as Exhibit 1 is a true copy an October 23, 2017 letter from the Commission’s Office of International Affairs (“OIA”) (OIA Ref. No. 2018-00030-003) to the Chinese Ministry of Justice (“MOJ”), which is the authority assigned by the People’s Republic of China to receive requests for service of process pursuant to the Hague Convention on the Service Abroad of Judicial and Extrajudicial Documents in Civil or Commercial Matters (the “Hague Convention”), 20 U.S.T. 361, T.I.A.S. 6638, 658 U.N.T.A. 163 (1964). This letter transmitted a Form USM-94 requesting service on respondent HXWWF to the MOJ, which

included the Order Instituting Proceedings (“OIP”) against HXWWF (File No. 3-18187), a letter from the Secretary of the Commission (“Secretary”) attaching the OIP, a letter from the Division offering discovery pursuant to Rule of Practice 201.230, and Chinese translations of the foregoing attachments, copies of which are attached hereto as Exhibit 2. The foregoing documents were sent to the MOJ by UPS, along with a similar package for service on a respondent in a separate proceeding. The package sent to the MOJ also included two checks for \$95 payable to the People’s Supreme Court of the People’s Republic of China for the service fee required for both respondents, as well as compact disks containing copies of the Forms USM-94, as required by the People’s Republic of China.

3. Attached hereto as Exhibit 3, is a copy of a UPS confirmation of delivery of Exhibits 1 and 2 to the MOJ on October 26, 2017.

4. Attached hereto as Exhibit 4 is a true copy of a March 30, 2017 letter from the OIA to the MOJ (OIA Ref. No. 2017-00837-001). This letter transmitted a Form USM-94 requesting service on respondent CXTIF, which included the OIP against CXTIF (File No. 3-17886), a letter from the Secretary, a letter from the Division offering discovery pursuant to Rule of Practice 201.230, and Chinese translations of the foregoing attachments, copies of all of which are attached hereto as Exhibit 5. The UPS delivered Exhibits 4 and 5 to the MOJ. The package sent to the MOJ also included a check for \$95 payable to the People’s Supreme Court of the People’s Republic of China for the required service fee, as well as compact disks containing copies of the Form USM-94, as required by the People’s Republic of China.

5. Attached hereto as Exhibit 6, is a copy of a UPS confirmation of delivery of Exhibits 4 and 5 to the MOJ on April 6, 2017.

6. Attached hereto as Exhibit 7 is a true copy of a screenshot from the website of the Registrar of the Cayman Islands showing the corporate status of CTXIF.

7. Attached hereto as Exhibit 8 is a true copy of a screenshot from the website of the Registrar of the Cayman Islands showing the corporate status of HXWWF

8. Attached hereto as Exhibit 9 is a report generated from Google Analytics, a website that monitors and analyzes worldwide web traffic. This report shows web traffic, by country, for the Commission's website, www.sec.gov for the period from March 21, 2017 through March 17, 2018. For that period, the total number of sessions for China was 4,939,404, or 4.93% of the total.

9. The following are true copies of definitions of selected columns presented in Exhibit 7 taken verbatim from the Google Analytics website. Note that definitions of the last three columns are not included because they relate to marketing analytics and are not relevant to this proceeding:

Country - The country from which the session originated.

Sessions - Total number of Sessions within the date range. A session is the period time a user is actively engaged with your website, app, etc. All usage data (Screen Views, Events, Ecommerce, etc.) is associated with a session.

% New Sessions - An estimate of the percentage of first time visits.

New Users - The number of first-time users during the selected date range.

Bounce Rate - The percentage of single-page sessions in which there was no interaction with the page. A bounced session has a duration of 0 seconds.

Pages / Session - Pages/Session (Average Page Depth) is the average number of pages viewed during a session. Repeated views of a single page are counted.

Avg. Session Duration - The average length of a Session.

10. Attached hereto as Exhibit 10 is a report generated by Google Analytics showing page views and other data specifically for the CTXIF OIP as it appears on www.sec.gov for the period from March 21, 2017 through September 20, 2017. This shows a total of 2,193 total page

views and 2,029 unique page views during that period, with the largest portion occurring during the first month after issuance.

11. Attached hereto as Exhibit 11 is a report generated by Google Analytics showing page views and other data specifically for the HXWWF OIP as it appears on www.sec.gov for the period from September 18, 2017 through March 17, 2018. This shows a total of 1,984 total page views and 1,906 unique page views during that period, again with the largest portion occurring during the first month after issuance.

12. The following are true copies of definitions of the columns presented in Exhibits 10 and 11 taken verbatim from the Google Analytics website. Note that the definition of the last column is not included because it relates to marketing analytics and is not relevant to this proceeding:

Page - The pages visited, listed by URI. The URI is the portion of a page's URL following the domain name; for example, the URI portion of www.example.com/contact.html is [/contact.html](#).

Pageviews - Pageviews is the total number of pages viewed. Repeated views of a single page are counted.

Unique Pageviews - Unique Pageviews is the number of sessions during which the specified page was viewed at least once. A unique pageview is counted for each page URL + page Title combination.

Avg. Time on Page - The average amount of time users spent viewing a specified page or screen, or set of pages or screens.

Entrances - Entrances is the number of times visitors entered your site through a specified page or set of pages.

Bounce Rate - The percentage of single-page sessions in which there was no interaction with the page. A bounced session has a duration of 0 seconds.

% Exit - %Exit is (number of exits) / (number of pageviews) for the page or set of pages. It indicates how often users exit from that page or set of pages when they view the page(s).

13. At the request of the Division, OIA has contacted the MOJ several times to ascertain the status of our service requests for CTXIF and HXWWF. The MOJ has responded

that the requests are with the courts for processing. The MOJ has never provided an estimate of when we can expect the return of service or attempted service.


14. As of this writing, the Division has yet to receive any return of service from the MOJ for either HXWWF or CTXIF.

15. Attached hereto as Exhibit 12 is a true copy of an email received by former Division co-counsel on May 15, 2018, from Ms. Laney Zhang, Foreign Law Specialist (China), Law Library of Congress, which contains an English translation of the Civil Procedure Law of the People's Republic of China, Chapter 7, "Time Periods and Service," Section 2, that was adopted by the National People's Congress on April 9, 1991, and last revised on August 31, 2012.

16. Attached hereto as Exhibit 13 is the Legal Notice that the Division proposes to publish in the International New York Times once a week for four weeks in the event the Court rejects our argument that publication on www.sec.gov is an effective means of service by publication, but permits us to serve the OIP by publication in the International New York Times.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct.

ORDER INSTITUTING ADMINISTRATIVE
PROCEEDINGS AND NOTICE OF HEARING
PURSUANT TO SECTION 12(j) OF THE
SECURITIES EXCHANGE ACT OF 1934

I.

The Securities and Exchange Commission (“Commission”) deems it necessary and appropriate for the protection of investors that public administrative proceedings be, and hereby are, instituted pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (“Exchange Act”) against the respondent named in the caption.

II.

After an investigation, the Division of Enforcement alleges that:

A. RESPONDENT ¹

1. Huixin Waste Water Solutions, Inc. (“HXWWF”) (CIK No. 1381807) is a Cayman Islands corporation located in Jiangmen City, Guangdong Province, China with a class of securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Exchange Act Section 12(g). HXWWF is delinquent in its periodic filings with the Commission, having not filed any periodic reports since it filed a Form 10-Q for the period ended September 30, 2013. As of September 13, 2017, the ordinary shares of HXWWF were quoted on OTC Link operated by OTC Markets Group, Inc. (formerly “Pink Sheets”) had three market makers and were eligible for the “piggyback” exception of Exchange Act Rule 15c2-11(f)(3).

B. DELINQUENT PERIODIC FILINGS

2. As discussed in more detail above, the Respondent is delinquent in its periodic filings with the Commission, has repeatedly failed to meet its obligations to file timely periodic

reports and failed to bring its filings current in response to the delinquency letter sent to it by the Division of Corporation Finance requesting compliance with its periodic filing obligations.

3. Exchange Act Section 13(a) and the rules promulgated thereunder require issuers of securities registered pursuant to Exchange Act Section 12 to file with the Commission current and accurate information in periodic reports, even if the registration is voluntary under Section 12(g). Specifically, Rule 13a-1 requires issuers to file annual reports and Rule 13a-13 requires domestic issuers to file quarterly reports.

4. As a result of the foregoing, the Respondent failed to comply with Exchange Act Section 13(a) and Rules 13a-1 and 13a-13 thereunder.

III.

In view of the allegations made by the Division of Enforcement, the Commission deems it necessary and appropriate for the protection of investors that public administrative proceedings be instituted to determine:

A. Whether the allegations contained in Section II hereof are true and, in connection therewith, to afford the Respondent an opportunity to establish any defenses to such allegations; and,

B. Whether it is necessary and appropriate for the protection of investors to suspend for a period not exceeding twelve months, or revoke the registration of each class of securities registered pursuant to Section 12 of the Exchange Act of the Respondent identified in Section II hereof, and any successor under Exchange Act Rules 12b-2 or 12g-3, and any new corporate names of the Respondent.

IV.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a public hearing for the purpose of taking evidence on the questions set forth in Section III hereof shall be convened at a time and place to be fixed, and before an Administrative Law Judge to be designated by further order as provided by Rule 110 of the Commission's Rules of Practice [17 C.F.R. § 201.110].

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the Respondent shall file an Answer to the allegations contained in this Order within ten (10) days after service of this Order, as provided by Rule 220(b) of the Commission's Rules of Practice [17 C.F.R. § 201.220(b)].

If the Respondent fails to file the directed Answer, or fails to appear at a hearing after being duly notified, the Respondent, and any successor under Exchange Act Rules 12b-2 or 12g-3, and any new corporate names of the Respondent, may be deemed in default and the proceedings may be determined against it upon consideration of this Order, the allegations of which may be deemed to be true as provided by Rules 155(a), 220(f), 221(f), and 310 of the Commission's Rules of Practice [17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), 201.220(f), 201.221(f), and 201.310].

This Order shall be served forthwith upon the Respondent by any means permitted by the Commission Rules of Practice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to Rule 360(a)(2) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, [17 C.F.R. § 201.360(a)(2)], the Administrative Law Judge shall issue an initial decision no later than [30] days from the occurrence of one of the following events: (A) The completion of post-hearing briefing in a proceeding where the hearing has been completed; (B) Where the hearing officer has determined that no hearing is necessary, upon completion of briefing on a motion pursuant to Rule 250 of the Commission's Rules of Practice, [17 C.F.R. § 201.250]; or (C) The determination by the hearing officer that a party is deemed to be in default under Rule 155 of the Commission's Rules of Practice, [17 C.F.R. § 201.155] and no hearing is necessary.

In the absence of an appropriate waiver, no officer or employee of the Commission engaged in the performance of investigative or prosecuting functions in this or any factually related proceeding will be permitted to participate or advise in the decision of this matter, except as witness or counsel in proceedings held pursuant to notice. Since this proceeding is not "rule making" within the meaning of Section 551 of the Administrative Procedure Act, it is not deemed subject to the provisions of Section 553 delaying the effective date of any final Commission action.

按照委員會《實務規則》第 155(a) 條規則、第 220(f) 條規則、第 221(f) 條規則和第 310 條規則【《美國聯邦法規》第 17 卷第 201.155(a) 節、第 201.220(f) 節、第 201.221(f) 節和第 201.310 節】規定，如果被告沒有提交規定的答辯狀或在被及時通知

后沒有出現在聽證會上，那麼被告、符合《交易法》第 12b-2 條規則或第 12g-3 條規則的任何繼承人以及被告名下的任何新公司有可能被視為失職方，基於本命令確定的訴訟有可能對其不利，且指控有可能被視為屬實。

I.

The Securities and Exchange Commission ("Commission") deems it necessary and appropriate for the protection of investors that public administrative proceedings be, and hereby are, instituted pursuant to Section 12(j) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 ("Exchange Act") against Respondents China Biopharma, Inc., China Linen Textile Industry, Ltd., China Water Group, Inc., Scout Exploration, Inc., and Teryl Resources Corp.

II.

After an investigation, the Division of Enforcement alleges that:

A. RESPONDENTS

1. China Biopharma, Inc. (CIK No. 1190132) is a void Delaware corporation located in Hangzhou, China with a class of securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Exchange Act Section 12(g). China Biopharma, Inc. is delinquent in its periodic filings with the Commission, having not filed any periodic reports since it filed a Form 10-Q for the period ended March 31, 2009, which reported a net loss of over \$15.88 million from September 13, 2000 to March 31, 2009. As of March 16, 2017, the company's stock (symbol "CHBO") was quoted on OTC Link (previously, "Pink

Sheets”) operated by OTC Markets Group, Inc. (“OTC Link”), had five market makers, and was eligible for the “piggyback” exception of Exchange Act Rule 15c2-11(f)(3).

2. China Linen Textile Industry, Ltd. (CIK No. 1336655) is a Cayman Islands corporation located in Heilongjiang Province, China with a class of securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Exchange Act Section 12(g). China Linen Textile Industry, Ltd. is delinquent in its periodic filings with the Commission, having not filed any periodic reports since it filed a Form 20-F for the period ended December 31, 2011. As of March 16, 2017, the company’s stock (symbol “CTXIF”) was quoted on OTC Link, had five market makers, and was eligible for the “piggyback” exception of Exchange Act Rule 15c2-11(f)(3).

3. China Water Group, Inc. (CIK No. 1083459) is a revoked Nevada corporation located in Guangdong, China with a class of securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Exchange Act Section 12(g). China Water Group, Inc. is delinquent in its periodic filings with the Commission, having not filed any periodic reports since it filed a Form 10-Q for the period ended September 30, 2013, which reported a net loss of \$503,075 for the prior nine months. As of March 16, 2017, the company’s stock (symbol “CHWG”) was quoted on OTC Link, had seven market makers, and was eligible for the “piggyback” exception of Exchange Act Rule 15c2-11(f)(3).

4. Scout Exploration, Inc. (CIK No. 1371474) is a Nevada corporation located in Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada with a class of securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Exchange Act Section 12(g). Scout Exploration, Inc. is delinquent in its periodic filings with the Commission, having not filed any periodic reports since it filed a Form 10-Q for the period ended June 30, 2013, which reported a net loss of \$893,117 for the prior three months. As of March 16, 2017, the company’s stock (symbol “SCXN”) was quoted on OTC Link, had six market makers, and was eligible for the “piggyback” exception of Exchange Act Rule 15c2-11(f)(3).

5. Teryl Resources Corp. (CIK No. 1109313) is a British Columbia corporation located in Richmond, British Columbia, Canada with a class of securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Exchange Act Section 12(g). Teryl Resources Corp. is delinquent in its periodic filings with the Commission, having not filed any periodic reports since it filed a Form 20-F for the period ended May 31, 2014, which reported a deficit of over \$12.9 million (Canadian) for the prior twelve months. As of March 16, 2017, the company’s stock (symbol “TRYLF”) was quoted on OTC Link, had five market makers, and was eligible for the “piggyback” exception of Exchange Act Rule 15c2-11(f)(3).

B. DELINQUENT PERIODIC FILINGS

6. As discussed in more detail above, all of the Respondents are delinquent in their periodic filings with the Commission, have repeatedly failed to meet their obligations to file timely periodic reports, and failed to heed delinquency letters sent to them by the Division of Corporation Finance requesting compliance with their periodic filing obligations or, through their failure to maintain a valid address on file with the Commission as required by Commission rules, did not receive such letters.

7. Exchange Act Section 13(a) and the rules promulgated thereunder require issuers of securities registered pursuant to Exchange Act Section 12 to file with the Commission current and accurate information in periodic reports, even if the registration is voluntary under Section 12(g). Specifically, Rule 13a-1 requires issuers to file annual reports, and Rule 13a-13 requires domestic issuers to file quarterly reports.

8. As a result of the foregoing, Respondents failed to comply with Exchange Act Section 13(a) and Rules 13a-1 and/or 13a-13 thereunder.

III.

In view of the allegations made by the Division of Enforcement, the Commission deems it necessary and appropriate for the protection of investors that public administrative proceedings be instituted to determine:

A. Whether the allegations contained in Section II hereof are true and, in connection therewith, to afford the Respondents an opportunity to establish any defenses to such allegations; and,

B. Whether it is necessary and appropriate for the protection of investors to suspend for a period not exceeding twelve months, or revoke the registration of each class of securities registered pursuant to Section 12 of the Exchange Act of the Respondents identified in Section II hereof, and any successor under Exchange Act Rules 12b-2 or 12g-3, and any new corporate names of any Respondents.

IV.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that a public hearing for the purpose of taking evidence on the questions set forth in Section III hereof shall be convened at a time and place to be fixed, and before an Administrative Law Judge to be designated by further order as provided by Rule 110 of the Commission's Rules of Practice [17 C.F.R. § 201.110].

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Respondents shall file an Answer to the allegations contained in this Order within ten (10) days after service of this Order, as provided by Rule 220(b) of the Commission's Rules of Practice [17 C.F.R. § 201.220(b)].

If Respondents fail to file the directed Answers, or fail to appear at a hearing after being duly notified, the Respondents, and any successor under Exchange Act Rules 12b-2 or 12g-3, and any new corporate names of any Respondents, may be deemed in default and the proceedings may be determined against them upon consideration of this Order, the allegations of which may be deemed to be true as provided by Rules 155(a), 220(f), 221(f), and 310 of the Commission's Rules of Practice [17 C.F.R. §§ 201.155(a), 201.220(f), 201.221(f), and 201.310].

This Order shall be served forthwith upon Respondents personally or by certified, registered, or Express Mail, or by other means permitted by the Commission Rules of Practice.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, pursuant to Rule 360(a)(2) of the Commission's Rules of Practice, 17 C.F.R. § 201.360(a)(2), the Administrative Law Judge shall issue an initial decision no later than 30 days from the occurrence of one of the following events: (A) The completion of post-hearing briefing in a proceeding where the hearing has been completed; (B) Where the hearing officer has determined that no hearing is necessary, upon completion of briefing on a motion pursuant to Rule 250 of the Commission's Rules of Practice, 17 C.F.R. § 201.250; or (C) The determination by the hearing officer that a party is deemed to be in default under Rule 155 of the Commission's Rules of Practice, 17 C.F.R. § 201.155 and no hearing is necessary.

In the absence of an appropriate waiver, no officer or employee of the Commission engaged in the performance of investigative or prosecuting functions in this or any factually related proceeding will be permitted to participate or advise in the decision of this matter, except as witness or counsel in proceedings held pursuant to notice. Since this proceeding is not "rule making" within the meaning of Section 551 of the Administrative Procedure Act, it is not deemed subject to the provisions of Section 553 delaying the effective date of any final Commission action.



(CIK 号为 1083459) 是一家已被撤销的内华达州公司, 位于中国广东。该公司根据《交易法》第 12(g)节规定在委员会进行了证券类别注册。China Water Group, Inc.未按规定向委员会提交定期报告。在递交了截止于 2013 年 9 月 30 日、汇报公司前九个月的净损失为 503,075 美元的 10-Q 表后, China Water Group, Inc.未曾递交过任何定期报告。截至 2017 年 2 月 21 日, 该公司股票 (股票代码为“CHWG”) 仍在 OTC Link 上挂牌交易, 拥有七家做市商, 并且符合《交易法》第 15c2-11(f)(3)条规则中的“捎带”例外资格。

4. Scout Exploration, Inc. B. 未按规定提交定期报告

6. 正如上文详述, 所有被告均未按规定向委员会提交定期报告, 屡次不履行按时提交定期报告的义务, 且在收到企业金融科发出的、要求其遵守定期提交报告义务的催告函后仍不予理会, 或因其没有遵守委员会关于在委员会档案中留下有效地址的规定而没有收到这些信函。

7. 《交易法》第 13(a)节及据此制定的规则要求按照《交易法》第 12 节规定注册的证券发行商必须以提交定期报告的形式向委员会提供最新和准确的信息,

即使按照第 12(g)节规定该注册是自发的。具体而言，第 13a-1 条规则要求发行商提交年度报告，而第 13a-13 条规则要求国内发行商提交季度报告。

8. 基于上述原因，被告未遵守《交易法》第 13(a)节以及据此制定的第 13a-1 条规则和/或第 13a-13 条规则的规定。

兹命令为对本文第 III 部分所述问题进行取证，应在指定时间和地点举行公开听证会。按照委员会《实务规则》第 110 条规则[《美国联邦法规》第 17 卷第 201.110 节]规定，该听证会应由进一步命令指定的行政法官主持。

兹在此进一步命令被告应按照委员会《实务规则》第 220(b)条规则[《美国联邦法规》第 17 卷第 201.220(b)节]规定，在本命令送达后 10 天内对本命令中包含的指控提交答辩状。

按照委员会《实务规则》第 155(a)条规则、第 220(f)条规则、第 221(f)条规则和第 310 条规则[《美国联邦法规》第 17 卷第 201.155(a)节、第 201.220(f)节、第 201.221(f)节和第 201.310 节]规定，如果被告没有提交规定的答辩状或在被及时通知后没有出现在听证会上，那么被告、符合《交易法》第 12b-2 条规则或第 12g-3 条规则规定的任何继承人以及被告名下的任何新公司有可能被视为失职方，基于本命令确定的诉讼有可能对其不利，且指控有可能被认为属实。

本命令应当面或以保证邮件、挂号信、快件以及委员会《实务规则》允许的其它方式立即送至被告处。

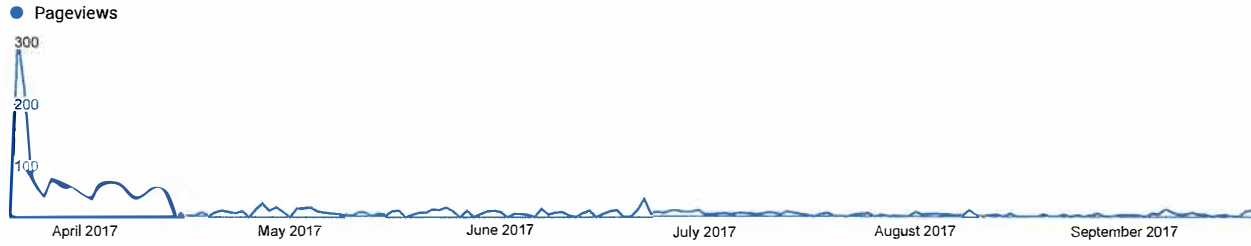

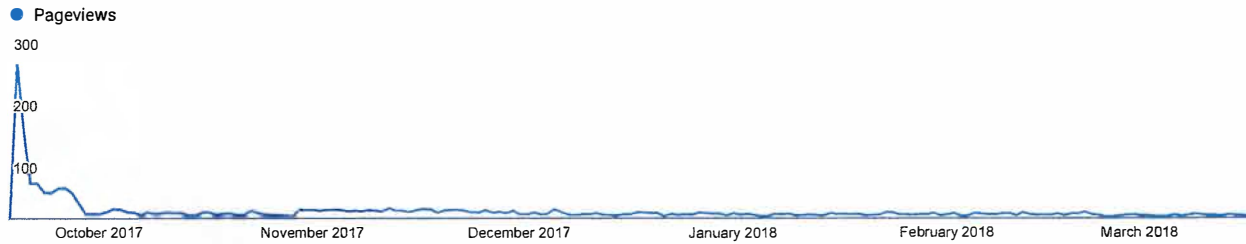

Dear Mr. Welch,

Below is the English translations of the articles under Section 2, "Service" of Chapter 7, "Time Periods and Service" of the Civil Procedure Law of the People's Republic of China (adopted by the National People's Congress on Apr. 9, 1991, last revised Aug. 31, 2012). The 2012 revised Law in the original Chinese language is available online at http://www.npc.gov.cn/npc/xinwen/2012-09/01/content_1735841_4.htm.

Article 84 A receipt shall be required for every litigation document that is served and it shall bear the date of receipt noted by the signature or seal of the person on whom the document is served. The date noted on the receipt by the person on whom the document is served shall be regarded as the date of service of the document.

Article 85 Litigation documents shall be sent or delivered directly to the person on whom they are to be served. If that person is a citizen, the documents shall, in case of his absence, be signed for receipt by an adult member of his family living with him. If the person on whom they are to be served is a legal person or any other organization, the documents shall be signed for receipt by the legal representatives of the legal person or the principal heads of the other organization or anyone of the legal person or the other organization responsible for receiving such documents; if the person on whom they are to be served has an agent ad litem, the documents may be signed for receipt by the agent ad litem; if the person on whom they are to be served has designated a person to receive litigation documents on his behalf and has informed the people's court of it, the documents shall be signed by the person designated for receipt.

The date put down in the receipt and signed by the adult family member living with the person on whom the litigation documents are to be served, or by the person responsible for receiving documents of a legal person or any other organization, or by the agent ad litem, or the person designated to receive documents shall be deemed the date of service of the documents.

Article 86 Where the person on whom the documents are served or his adult relatives who live with him refuse to accept the litigation documents, the documents shall be deemed to have been served if the person serving the documents invites the representative of the relevant primary-level organization or the employer of that person to explain the situations and clearly state the cause and date of refusal on the certificate of delivery, and then leaves the litigation documents at the domicile of that person, with the signatures or seals of the person serving the documents and the witness affixed, or if the person serving the documents leaves the litigation documents at the domicile of the

person on whom the documents are served after recording the whole service process by photographing or video recording.

Article 87 With the consent of the person on whom the documents are served, the people's court may serve litigation documents in such manners that the receipt of the documents can be confirmed by the person on whom the documents are served, including facsimile and e-mail, except for the serving of judgment, ruling or mediation agreement.

Where the litigation documents are served in the manners as specified above, the date on which the facsimile or e-mail arrives at the specific system of the recipient shall be the date of service.

Article 88 If direct service proves to be difficult, service of litigation documents may be entrusted to another people's court, or done by mail. If the documents are served by mail, the date of receiving such documents stated on the receipt for postal delivery shall be deemed the date of service of the documents.

Article 89 If the person on whom the litigation documents are to be served is a serviceman, the documents shall be forwarded to him through the political organ of the unit at or above the regimental level in the force to which he belongs.

Article 90 If the person on whom the litigation documents are to be served is in imprisonment, the documents shall be forwarded to him through the prison authorities where the person is serving his term.

If the person on whom the litigation documents are to be served is undergoing mandatory education measures, the documents shall be forwarded to him through the mandatory education organizations where such person is being educated.

Article 91 The organization or unit that receives the litigation documents to be forwarded must immediately deliver them to the person on whom they are to be served for receipt. The date stated on the receipt shall be deemed the date of service of the documents.

Article 92 If the whereabouts of the person on whom the litigation documents are to be served is unknown, or if the documents cannot be served by the other methods specified in this Section, the documents shall be served by public announcement. 60 days after the date of making a public announcement, the documents shall be deemed to have been served.

The reasons for service by public announcement and the process gone through shall be recorded in the case files.

TO: China Linen Textile Industry, Ltd. and Huixin Wastewater Solutions, Inc.

You are each a respondent in separate administrative proceedings (“APs”) brought by the United States Securities and Exchange Commission (the “Commission”). The Commission alleged in separate Orders Instituting Proceedings (“OIPs”) that you have a class of securities registered with the Commission pursuant to Exchange Act Section 12(g), and that you are delinquent in your periodic filings with the Commission, having not filed any periodic reports in several years. Accordingly, you failed to comply with Exchange Act Section 13(a) and Rules 13a-1 and 13a-13 thereunder.

Each APs purpose is to find whether it is necessary and appropriate for the protection of investors to suspend for a period not exceeding twelve months, or revoke, the registration of each class of your securities registered pursuant to Section 12 of the Exchange Act. The Commission attempted to serve you with the appropriate OIP through China’s Ministry of Justice (“MOJ”) under the Hague Service Convention (1965). However, the MOJ has failed to provide the Commission with a certificate of service or delivery within six months of receipt of the OIP from the Commission, so the Commission’s Division of Enforcement has filed a Motion for Entry of a Default Judgment (“Motion”) against you pursuant to Article 15 of the Hague Service Convention.

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that if you wish to contest the Motion, you are required to file an Opposition in English by _____, 2019 by mail or facsimile to: Secretary, U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission, 100 F St., NE, Washington, DC 20549, (202) 551-9324 (fax).
