ORDER VACATING BROKER, DEALER, MUNICIPAL SECURITIES DEALER, MUNICIPAL ADVISOR, TRANSFER AGENT, AND NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED STATISTICAL RATING ORGANIZATION BARS

Frances M. Guggino a/k/a Frances Favata seeks to vacate an order, dated August 23, 2012 (the "Order"), to the extent that it bars her from association with a broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, municipal advisor, transfer agent, or nationally recognized statistical rating organization. The bars at issue were imposed based solely on conduct occurring prior to July 22, 2010, the effective date of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act. Accordingly, in our discretion, we vacate the Order to the extent it prohibits Frances M. Guggino a/k/a Frances Favata from associating with a broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, municipal advisor, transfer agent, or nationally recognized statistical rating organization, but otherwise leave the Order unmodified.
