**ORDER VACATING MUNICIPAL SECURITIES DEALER AND TRANSFER AGENT
BARS**

Jerry Gruenbaum, Esq., seeks to vacate an order, dated June 29, 2015 (the “Order”), to the extent that it bars him from association with a municipal securities dealer or transfer agent.¹ The bars at issue were imposed based solely on conduct occurring prior to July 22, 2010, the effective date of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act.² Accordingly, in our discretion, we vacate the Order to the extent it prohibits Jerry Gruenbaum, Esq., from associating with a municipal securities dealer or transfer agent, but otherwise leave the Order unmodified.
