**ORDER VACATING BROKER, DEALER, MUNICIPAL SECURITIES DEALER,
MUNICIPAL ADVISOR, TRANSFER AGENT, AND NATIONALLY RECOGNIZED
STATISTICAL RATING ORGANIZATION BARS**

Bruce F. Prevost and David W. Harrold seek to vacate an order, dated September 23, 2011 (the “Order”), to the extent that it bars them from association with a broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, municipal advisor, transfer agent, or nationally recognized statistical rating organization.¹ The bars at issue were imposed based solely on conduct occurring prior to July 22, 2010, the effective date of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act.² Accordingly, in our discretion, we vacate the Order to the extent it prohibits Bruce F. Prevost and David W. Harrold from associating with a broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, municipal advisor, transfer agent, or nationally recognized statistical rating organization, but otherwise leave the Order unmodified.
