## ORDER REGARDING SERVICE

On September 22, 2022, the Securities and Exchange Commission issued an Order Instituting Administrative Proceedings ("OIP") against Ira S. Viener, CPA, pursuant to Sections 4C and 21C of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 102(e) of the Commission's Rules of Practice. It appears that since the issuance of the OIP, there have been no filings regarding whether the OIP was served upon Viener. Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that the Division of Enforcement file a status report concerning service of the OIP by October 11, 2022, and every 14 days thereafter until service is accomplished.

The parties' attention is directed to the most recent amendments to the Commission's Rules of Practice, which took effect on April 12, 2021, and which include e-filing requirements.<sup>2</sup>
