**ORDER OF SUSPENSION OF
TRADING**

It appears to the Securities and Exchange Commission that there is a lack of current and accurate information concerning the securities of GeoGlobal Resources, Inc. (CIK No. 896726), a void Delaware corporation with its principal place of business listed as Calgary, Alberta, Canada with stock quoted on OTC Link (previously, "Pink Sheets") operated by OTC Markets Group, Inc. ("OTC Link") under the ticker symbol GGLR, because it has not filed any periodic reports since the period ended September 30, 2012. On December 21, 2016, a delinquency letter was sent by the Division of Corporation Finance to GeoGlobal Resources, Inc. requesting compliance with its periodic filing obligations, and GeoGlobal Resources, Inc. did not receive the delinquency letter due to its failure to maintain a valid address on file with the Commission as required by Commission rules (Rule 301 of Regulation S-T, 17 CFR 232.301 and Section 5.4 of EDGAR Filer Manual).

It appears to the Securities and Exchange Commission that there is a lack of current and accurate information concerning the securities of USA Synthetic Fuel Corp. (CIK No. 1487920), a void Delaware corporation with its principal place of business listed as Cincinnati, Ohio with stock quoted on OTC Link under the ticker symbol USFCQ, because it has not filed any periodic reports since the period ended June 30, 2014. On December 21, 2016, a delinquency letter was sent by the Division of Corporation Finance to USA Synthetic Fuel Corp. requesting compliance with its periodic filing obligations, and USA Synthetic Fuel Corp. received the delinquency letter on December 24, 2016, but failed to cure its delinquencies.

The Commission is of the opinion that the public interest and the protection of investors require a suspension of trading in the securities of the above-listed companies.

Therefore, it is ordered, pursuant to Section 12(k) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, that trading in the securities of the above-listed companies is suspended for the period from 9:30 a.m. EDT on September 6, 2017, through 11:59 p.m. EDT on September 19, 2017.
