**ORDER OF SUSPENSION OF
TRADING**

It appears to the Securities and Exchange Commission that there is a lack of current and accurate information concerning the securities of Blacksands Petroleum, Inc. (CIK No. 1308137), a revoked Nevada corporation with its principal place of business listed as Houston, Texas with stock quoted on OTC Link (previously, "Pink Sheets") operated by OTC Markets Group, Inc. ("OTC Link") under the ticker symbol BSPE, because it has not filed any periodic reports since the period ended April 30, 2015. On July 24, 2017, a delinquency letter was sent by the Division of Corporation Finance to Blacksands Petroleum, Inc. requesting compliance with its periodic filing obligations, and Blacksands Petroleum, Inc. did not receive the delinquency letter due to its failure to maintain a valid address on file with the Commission as required by Commission rules (Rule 301 of Regulation S-T, 17 CFR 232.301 and Section 5.4 of EDGAR Filer Manual).

It appears to the Securities and Exchange Commission that there is a lack of current and accurate information concerning the securities of China Education Alliance, Inc. (CIK No. 1203900), a North Carolina corporation with its principal place of business listed as Harbin, China with stock quoted on OTC Link under the ticker symbol CEAI, because it has not filed any periodic reports since the period ended September 30, 2015. On July 27, 2017, a delinquency letter was sent by the Division of Corporation Finance to China Education Alliance, Inc. requesting compliance with its periodic filing obligations, but China Education Alliance, Inc. did not receive the delinquency letter due to its failure to maintain a valid address on file with the Commission as required by Commission rules (Rule 301 of Regulation S-T, 17 CFR 232.301 and Section 5.4 of EDGAR Filer Manual).

It appears to the Securities and Exchange Commission that there is a lack of current and accurate information concerning the securities of DoMark International, Inc. (CIK No. 1365160), a defaulted Nevada corporation with its principal place of business listed as London, England with stock quoted on OTC Link under the ticker symbol DOMK, because it has not filed any periodic reports since the period ended February 29, 2016. On July 27, 2017, a delinquency letter was sent by the Division of Corporation Finance to DoMark International, Inc. requesting compliance with its periodic filing obligations, but DoMark International, Inc. refused delivery of the delinquency letter on August 20, 2017.

It appears to the Securities and Exchange Commission that there is a lack of current and accurate information concerning the securities of East Coast Diversified Corp. (CIK No. 1256540), a revoked Nevada corporation with its principal place of business listed as Marietta, Georgia with stock quoted on OTC Link under the ticker symbol ECDC, because it has not filed any periodic reports since the period ended

September 30, 2015. On July 27, 2017, a delinquency letter was sent by the Division of Corporation Finance to East Coast Diversified Corp. requesting compliance with its periodic filing obligations, but East Coast Diversified Corp. did not receive the delinquency letter due to its failure to maintain a valid address on file with the Commission as required by Commission rules (Rule 301 of Regulation S-T, 17 CFR 232.301 and Section 5.4 of EDGAR Filer Manual).

The Commission is of the opinion that the public interest and the protection of investors require a suspension of trading in the securities of the above-listed companies.

Therefore, it is ordered, pursuant to Section 12(k) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, that trading in the securities of the above-listed companies is suspended for the period from 9:30 a.m. EST on January 9, 2018, through 11:59 p.m. EST on January 23, 2018.
