COMMENT PERIOD EXTENDED ON RULE 10b-10

U.S. SECURITIES AND EXCHANGE COMMISSION

The Commission has extended the comment period until November 29 for proposed Rule 10b-10 which would revise current confirmation requirements. (Rel. 34-12968)

ADOPTION OF RULE 19g2-1

The Commission announced the adoption of Rule 19g2-1 effective December 20, 1976. Rule 19g2-1 relieves national securities exchanges and registered securities associations from certain obligations to enforce compliance with the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and the rules thereunder by their members and persons associated with a member. AMENDED FORM S-8 ADOPTED; COMMENTS INVITED ON RULE 153 AND A PROPOSED NEW RULE 480

The Commission announced the adoption of amendments to Form S-8, the short registration form available for offers of securities made to employees of the issuer and its affiliates, pursuant to certain employee benefit plans. The Commission issued the amendments for comment in July, 1976 and received over 160 letters of comment. In considering these comments, the Commission has, in addition to responding with significant modifications to further simplify the disclosure requirements, made major changes to: (1) delete the regulatory conditions governing the availability of the form; (2) modify the limitations on the use of the form for reoffers and resales; and (3) delete the requirement for an opinion of counsel concerning compliance with the Employee Retirement and Income Security Act.

As proposed, Form S-8 would not have allowed reoffers to be made by affiliates or underwriters through the use of the Form S-8 prospectus. The amended Form continues with this prohibition in the use of a Form S-8 prospectus for reoffers and resales by "affiliates", but goes on to allow any affiliates to make registered reoffers of certain amounts of securities acquired pursuant to a registration statement on Form S-8 through the use of a Form S-16 prospectus. The S-16 prospectus can be filed as a part of the registration statement on Form S-8 and need not be the subject of a new, separate registration statement.

The amendments become effective for all registration statements and post-effective amendments filed on Form S-8 after December 31, 1976.

In related action, the Commission also published for comment a proposed Rule 480 and amendments to Rule 459 in order to provide a means by which certain post-effective amendments to registration statements on Form S-8 would become effective automatically, not less than 20 days after filing, without affirmative action by the Commission. The Commission is also requesting comments and suggestions on extending the prospectus delivery procedures of Rule 153 for over-the-counter transactions in securities, including those in connection with reoffers and resales of securities registered on Form S-8. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

SPORTS FUND

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 14 to request a hearing on a proposal by the Commission to declare, by order on its own motion, that Sports Fund has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-9538 - Nov. 19)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

JERSEY CENTRAL POWER & LIGHT COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing Jersey Central Power & Light Company, subsidiary of General Public Utilities Corporation, to sell certain property acquired for a pumped storage and/or air storage facility to an unaffiliated purchaser. (Rel. 35-19761 - Nov. 19)

NEW ENGLAND POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing New England Power Company, subsidiary of New England Electric System, to solicit proxies from a class of its preferred stock in connection with a proposed sale of utility assets. (Rel. 35-19762 - Nov. 19)

THE CONNECTICUT LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 13 to request a hearing on proposals of The Connecticut Light and Power Company, The Hartford Electric Light Company and Western Massachusetts Electric Company, all of which are subsidiaries of Northeast Utilities, to sell all or part of their respective interests in four nuclear fired electric generating units which are presently under construction at three sites in New England for an estimated price of \$60 million. The interests are being sold in order to reduce the capital expenditure programs of the subsidiaries and to thereby reduce their revenue requirements. (Rel. 35-19763 - Nov. 19)

DELMARVA POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY

An order has been issued regarding Delmarva Power and Light Company, a recently exempted holding company, permitting the withdrawal of an application-declaration regarding the sale and issuance of a secured promissory note in principal amount not in excess of \$40 million to repay pollution control revenue bonds issued by the Department of Community Affairs and Economic Development of the State of Delaware. NORTHEAST UTILITIES

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 14 to request a hearing on a proposal of Northeast Utilities, a registered holding company, to issue and sell up to 500,000 shares of common stock pursuant to a dividend reinvestment and stock purchase plan.
