## NOTICE OF COMMISSION MEETINGS

U.S. SECURITIES AND  
EXCHANGE COMMISSION

Following is a schedule of Commission meetings which will be conducted pursuant to provisions of the Government in the Sunshine Act. In general, the Commission expects to follow a schedule of holding closed meetings on Tuesdays, and open meetings on Thursday morning. Meetings on Wednesday, and if necessary on Thursday afternoons, will be either open or closed according to the requirements of agenda items under consideration. The Commission will not normally meet on Mondays or Fridays.

Visitors are welcome at all open meetings, insofar as space is available.

Meetings will be held in the Commission Meeting Room, Room 1C30, at the Commission's headquarters building, 450 Fifth Street, N.W., Washington, DC. Persons wishing to photograph or videotape Commission meetings must obtain permission in advance from the Secretary of the Commission. Persons wishing to tape record a Commission meeting should notify the Secretary's office 48 hours in advance of the meeting.

### OPEN MEETING - TUESDAY, DECEMBER 21, 1982 - 10:00 A.M.

The subject matter of the December 21 open meeting will be:

- (1) Consideration of whether to propose for public comment new Form N-1A and certain related guidelines and rule amendments. The new form, which would be used by open-end management investment companies for registration under the Investment Company Act of 1940 and the Securities Act of 1933, would use a simplified prospectus. - (2) Consideration of whether to amend 17 CFR 201.22(e), 230.403(a), 240.12b-12(a) and (b), 250.22(d), 260.7a-17, 260.7a-18, 270.0-2(b), 270.8b-12(a) and (b), and 275.0-4(b), which would require the use of paper measuring no larger than 8-1/2 x 11 inches in size for documents filed with the Commission. - (3) Consideration of whether to propose for comment two alternative sets of amendments to its rules for application of the full cost method of accounting by oil and gas producers. The proposed amendments are intended to clarify the criteria for determining which capitalized costs may be excluded from immediate amortization. They would thereby narrow the diversity of practice resulting from varying interpretations of the Commission's existing rules which permit the exclusion from amortization of "unusually significant" costs of unproved properties and major development projects. The Commission will also consider proposing amendments to clarify its rules on the recognition of gain or loss on sales of oil and gas producing properties. FOR FURTHER INFORMATION, PLEASE CONTACT M. 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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### FINANCIAL RESERVES FUND

An order has been issued on an application filed by Financial Reserves Fund, formerly, Short Term Interest Fund, an open-end, diversified, management investment company, pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act of 1940, exempting Applicant, subject to conditions, from the provisions of Section 2(a)(41) of the Act and Rules 2a-4 and 22c-1 thereunder to the extent necessary to permit Applicant to use the amortized cost method of valuing its portfolio securities. 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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### NEW ENGLAND POWER COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing New England Power Company, subsidiary of New England Electric System, to finance additional pollution control expenditures through an arrangement with the Massachusetts Industrial Finance Agency (MIFA) for the issuance on December 28, 1982 of up to \$15 million of short-term, unsecured, tax-exempt bonds. Jurisdiction has been reserved with respect to the issuance and sale of up to \$25 million of general and refunding mortgage bonds and pledge bonds to repay MIFA for its long-term pollution control bonds. 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## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

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### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The following have filed proposed rule changes pursuant to Rule 19b-4: The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. has filed its second amendment (SR-NASD-80-10) to provide for the listing and trading of additional index options. Amendment 2 designates seven additional NASDAQ indices for index options trading. (Rel. 34-19330); and The American Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-Amex-82-23) to amend the Amex Constitution to permit the designation of authorized representatives to act on the Exchange floor on behalf of Options Principal Member (OPM) Governors of the Exchange and regular member and OPM Exchange Officials.
