## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

---

### STOP ORDER PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST MILITARY ROBOT CORPORATION

The Commission instituted stop order proceedings suspending the effectiveness of the registration statement filed by Military Robot Corporation of Longmont, Colorado respecting an initial public offering of five million shares, \$.01 par value, common stock. The Commission instituted stop order proceedings on the basis of allegations by the Division of Enforcement that Military Robot's registration statement is materially false and misleading. Among other things, the Division of Enforcement alleged that the registration statement: fails to disclose that Military Robot may have contingent liabilities of at least \$15,000 as a result of sales of unregistered securities in a predecessor corporation, Universal Military Robot Corporation; contains 1985 sales projections for which there is no reasonable basis; falsely names a firm as the accounting firm for Military Robot when the company is not currently a client of that firm; and makes various unsupported and misleading statements respecting Military Robot's products and business.

Bernard C. Lumbert is the President, Chief Executive Officer, Treasurer and sole Director of Military Robot and Universal. (Rel. 33-6572)

## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

---

### COMPLAINT NAMES CHARLES D'ANGELO

The Boston Regional Office filed a complaint on March 19 in the U.S. District Court for the District of Connecticut seeking injunctive relief against Charles D'Angelo of Torrington, Connecticut for violating the antifraud provisions of the Securities and Exchange Acts. The complaint alleges that from December 1979 through July 1984, while employed as branch manager of the Waterbury, Connecticut office of Smith Barney,

Harris Upham and Co., Inc., D'Angelo misappropriated approximately \$800,000 from Smith Barney clients. According to the complaint, D'Angelo perpetrated the fraud by causing unauthorized checks to be drawn on clients' accounts, forging the clients' signatures thereon and depositing most of the unauthorized, forged checks in bank accounts he controlled. Simultaneously with the filing of the complaint, D'Angelo entered into a Consent Decree in which he consented to a Final Order of Permanent Injunction enjoining him from future violations of the antifraud provisions of the Securities and Exchange Acts. ## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

---

### ALABAMA POWER COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 17 to request a hearing on a proposal by Alabama Power Company, subsidiary of The Southern Company, to engage in transactions in its planned Weatherization Financing Program for its customers. (Rel. 35-23637 - March 22)

### NEW ENGLAND ELECTRIC SYSTEM

An order has been issued authorizing a proposal by New England Electric System (NEES), a registered holding company, and its subsidiary, NEES Energy, Inc., for the financing of NEES Energy through capital contributions and non-interest bearing loans by NEES not to exceed \$23 million, and guarantees by NEES to the extent required for NEES Energy to obtain performance and surety bonds in its business activities. ### MIDDLE SOUTH UTILITIES, INC.

An order has been issued regarding Middle South Utilities, Inc., a registered holding company, and its subsidiary, Middle South Services, Inc., authorizing Services to borrow and reborrow from Middle South up to an aggregate principal amount of \$30 million at any one time outstanding. (Rel. 35-23640 - March 25)

## SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

---

### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved proposed rule changes filed by: The Chicago Board Options Exchange, Inc. (SR-CBOE-85-4) which requires CBOE member firms to process their accounts receivable and deliver invoices to member firms for which they have performed floor brokerage services, within the first five business days of a month, in order to qualify for payment later in the same month. (Rel. 34-21884); (SR-CBOE-84-34) that permits a bank to issue a Treasury security escrow receipt that is collateralized by Treasury bonds other than the Treasury bonds underlying the Treasury bond option the escrow receipt covers. (Rel. 34-21886); and The American Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-Amex-84-40) to permit the use of index option escrow receipts as cover, in lieu of margin, for short options positions in narrow-based index options. (Rel. 34-21888)

### ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved, on an accelerated basis, a proposed rule change filed by The Chicago Board Options Exchange, Inc. (SR-CBOE-85-5) to amend CBOE Rule 9.21 (Communications to Customers) to conform its rules with the Commission's 1984 amendments to Rule 134a under the Securities Act of 1933 relating to the content of written options materials disseminated to the public. ## TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

---

### ACF INDUSTRIES, INC.

An order has been issued under the Trust Indenture Act on an application by ACF Industries, Inc. that the trusteeship of the Mercantile-Safe Deposit and Trust Company under two Equipment Trust Agreements is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify the Trust Company from acting as trustee. ### PRUDENTIAL-BACHE SECURITIES INC.

An order has been issued exempting Prudential-Bache Securities Inc. and MGP Limited Partnership from the provisions of Section 205(1) of the Investment Advisers Act to permit a performance fee upon the profits and losses of a proposed limited partnership, and granting confidential treatment to the limited partnership agreement. Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
