CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

WILLIAM G. KUHEN PERMANENTLY ENJOINED

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that on July 1 Judge A. Joe Fish, U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas, Dallas Division, entered an order of permanent injunction against William G. Kuhen, a former resident of Dallas, Texas now residing in Macon, Georgia. The order permanently enjoins Kuhen from violations of the registration and antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Investment Advisers Act of 1940, the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and the registration provisions of the Investment Company Act of 1940.

The June 11 complaint alleges that: (1) Kuhen raised \$5-\$6 million from approximately 340 investors through the offer and sale of securities in the form of promissory notes; (2) the funds obtained from the sale of the notes were pooled, managed by Kuhen, and invested in the options market in violation of the registration provisions of the securities laws; and (3) Kuhen violated the antifraud provisions of the securities laws by misrepresenting that investors would receive a guaranteed 40 percent annual interest rate on the notes, that they would be allowed to share in profits earned from the options trading, and that his options program was profitable. (SEC v. William G. Kuhen, USDC/ND/TX/Dallas Div., No. CA3-85-1090-G). (LR-10822)

RESTRAINING ORDER ISSUED IN NEW HAMPSHIRE CASE

The Boston Regional Office filed a complaint on July 10 in the U.S. District Court for the District of New Hampshire (Concord) against Secured Lending Associates, Inc. (SLA) and Woodford Chapman, SLA's president, both of Windham, New Hampshire, and Stephen Peabody of Nashua, New Hampshire, SLA's controller.

The complaint alleges that since at least June 1983, Chapman, Peabody and SLA violated the registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The Commission's papers relate that SLA was the subject of a cease and desist order issued by the Securities Division for the Commonwealth of Massachusetts on November 14, 1984 in its offer and sale of unregistered securities in that state but continued the complained of activities.

The defendants concurred in the entry of a temporary restraining order which was issued by Judge Martin F. Loughlin on July 10, 1982. (SEC v. Woodford Chapman, et al., DCNH, Civil Action No. C85-435L). (LR-10823)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

KOENIG TAX-ADVANTAGED LIQUIDITY FUND, INC.

An order has been issued exempting Koenig Tax-Advantaged Liquidity Fund, Inc. from the provisions of Section 19(b) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 19b-1 to permit it to distribute long-term capital gains more than once in any one taxable year. (Rel. IC-14630 - July 16)

PARKWAY U.S. GOVERNMENT TRUST; DMC CORPORATE DIVIDEND FUND, INC.

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until August 9 to request a hearing on an application by Parkway U.S. Government Trust and DMC Corporate Dividend Fund, Inc. for an order declaring that they have ceased to be investment companies. (Rel. IC-14631 - July 16; IC-14633 - July 15)

FEDERATED FUNDS

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 6 to request a hearing on an application filed by Federated Investors, Inc. (Federated) and the Federated Funds, including all future investment companies advised or underwritten by subsidiaries or affiliates of Federated, requesting an order granting an exemption from Section 17(a) of the Investment Company Act to permit purchase of fidelity insurance from an affiliate and settlement of claims arising therefrom. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY

An order has been issued authorizing National Fuel Gas Company, a registered holding company, to acquire the common stock of a newly formed subsidiary, Highland Land and Minerals, Inc. (Rel. 35-23764 - July 15)

CENTRAL POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested parties until August 6 to request a hearing on a proposal by Central Power and Light Company, subsidiary of Central and South West Corporation, to make a tender offer for \$150 million of its securities, and to issue and sell \$90 million of first mortgage bonds and \$95 million of debentures. (Rel. 35-23765 - July 16)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved proposed rule changes filed under Rule 19b-4 by: The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. (SR-NASD-85-14) to amend its Uniform Practice Code to require the settlement of syndicate accounts by the syndicate manager within 120 days following the syndicate settlement date. (Rel. 34-22238); and the Options Clearing Corporation (SR-OCC-83-22) that institutes procedures governing facilities management arrangements of OCC Clearing Members. (Rel. 34-22239)

PARTIAL APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission partially approved a proposed rule change filed under Rule 19b-4 by The American Stock Exchange, Inc. (SR-Amex-84-41) which provides that stop and stop limit option orders become effective when the market quotation on the same side of the market equals the price on the order. (Rel. 34-22240)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers, Inc. filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b(3) (SR-NASD-85-18) to establish new fees for the use of the its Computer Assisted Execution System. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of July 15. (Rel. 34-22241)

TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

STORAGE EQUITIES, INC.

Orders have been issued under the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 on applications filed by Storage Equities, Inc. that the trusteeship of Trust Services of America, Inc. is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary to disqualify Trust Services from acting as trustee under a seventh and sixth supplemental indenture to existing indentures qualified under the Act. (Rel. TI-1001; TI-1002)
