ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST JAMES LAIACONA

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and the Securities Investor Protection Act of 1970 against James Laiacona. The Order alleges that Laiacona, president and sole stockholder of a broker-dealer registered with the Commission, misappropriated funds provided by customers to the broker-dealer in connection with the purchase of securities, and failed to disclose to such customers that the broker-dealer had failed to maintain the minimum net capital required. Thus, the Order alleges that Laiacona wilfully violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the Exchange Act.

The Order also alleges that Laiacona aided and abetted violations by the broker-dealer of other provisions of the Exchange Act, including failure to maintain net capital (Rule 15c3-1); violation of the customer protection rule (Rule 15c3-3); violation of the provisions concerning the making and preserving of certain records (Section 17(a) and Rules 17a-3, 17a-4 and 17a-5); and failure to give timely telegraphic notice to the Commission and the NASD of net capital violations (Rule 17a-11).

A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations are true and, if so, what, if any, remedial action is appropriate. (Rel. 34-23047)

PROCEEDINGS INSTITUTED AGAINST EUGENE CHIARAMONTE AND DAVID RAPAPORT

The Commission ordered public administrative proceedings under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 against Eugene Joseph Chiaramonte and David James Rapaport, associated in various capacities at various times with registered broker-dealers in the New York metropolitan area.

The Order Instituting Proceedings alleges that Chiaramonte and Rapaport were convicted in U.S. District Court on June 19, 1985, upon a plea of guilty, of tax evasion and filing of false tax return, respectively.

A hearing will be scheduled to determine whether the allegations against Chiaramonte and Rapaport are true and, if so, to decide what, if any, remedial action is appropriate. (Rel. 34-23049)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE PIEDMONT INCOME FUND, INC.

A second notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 21 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Piedmont Income Fund, Inc., for an order to amend a previous order (Rel. IC-14239, November 16, 1984) that permitted it to invest in options on stock indexes, stock index futures contracts and options on stock index futures contracts. (Rel. IC-15020 - March 31)

HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE COLUMBIA GAS SYSTEM, INC.

A supplemental order has been issued regarding The Columbia Gas System, Inc., a registered holding company, and certain of its subsidiaries, extending the Intercompany Financing, External Short-Term Financing and Money Pool Program through December 31, 1987. The supplemental order releases jurisdiction over the transactions by Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc., Columbia Gas of Virginia, Inc., Commonwealth Gas Services, Inc. and Commonwealth Gas Pipeline Corporation. Jurisdiction continues to be reserved over the transactions by those applicants-declarants who are subject to state jurisdiction pending completion of the record. (Rel. 35-24059 - March 31)

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
