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### SECURITIES ISSUED OR GUARANTEED BY UNITED STATES BRANCHES OR AGENCIES OF FOREIGN BANKS

The Commission issued an interpretive release stating that a branch of agency of a foreign bank located in the United States is deemed to be a "national bank" or a "banking institution organized under the laws of any State, Territory, or the District of Columbia" for purposes of the exemption from the registration requirements provided by Section 3(a)(2) of the Securities Act of 1933, provided that the nature and extent of federal and/or state regulation and supervision of the branch or agency is substantially equivalent to that applicable to federal or state chartered domestic banks doing business in the same jurisdiction. 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## COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

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### BRANDON BECKER APPOINTED NEW ASSOCIATE DIRECTOR FOR THE OFFICE OF SELF-REGULATORY OVERSIGHT

Brandon Becker has been appointed the new Associate Director for the Office of Self-Regulatory Oversight in the Division of Market Regulation, effective immediately. He replaces Richard T. Chase who left the Commission last summer to become the Executive Vice-President of the Philadelphia Stock Exchange. Mr. Becker joined the Commission in 1978 as an attorney in the Division's Office of Legal Policy and Trading Practices. Since then, he has held a variety of positions of increasing responsibility within the Commission, including serving as a Legal Assistant to former Commissioner Barbara S. Thomas. Most recently, he served as the Division's Assistant Director for Options and Exchange Regulation. Mr. Becker obtained his LL.M. degree from Columbia Law School, his J.D. degree from the University of San Diego School of Law, and his B.A. degree from the University of Minnesota at Minneapolis.

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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### COMPLAINT NAMES INTERNATIONAL TELDATA CORPORATION, OTHERS

The San Francisco Branch Office filed a complaint on September 16 in the federal district court in Las Vegas, Nevada seeking permanent injunctions against Charles W. Anshen, Richard J. Candelaria, Estelle Eizenberg Anshen, International Teldata Corporation, Louis Miranti, and Edward R. Talbot. The complaint charges the Anshens, Candelaria, Teldata and Talbot with violations of the registration provisions of the securities laws relating to the unregistered issuance and distribution of Teldata stock. Candelaria, the Anshens, Miranti and Talbot are also charged with violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws in connection with several schemes to misappropriate Teldata stock worth in excess of \$5 million. In addition, Teldata, Candelaria and Miranti are charged with violations of the issuer reporting provisions; Charles Anshen and Candelaria are charged with making misrepresentations to Teldata's auditors; and Candelaria and Miranti are charged with stock ownership reporting violations. 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### ZERO COUPON BOND FUND

An order has been issued granting Zero Coupon Bond Fund, et al., exemptions from the requirements of Sections 9(a), 13(a), 15(a), and 15(b) of the Investment Company Act and Rules 6e-2(b)(15) and 6e-3(T)(b)(15) to permit certain life insurance companies and variable life insurance separate accounts to utilize the Zero Coupon Bond Fund for mixed funding and shared funding.
