CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

ESTHER I. LAWRENCE ENJOINED

The Commission announced that on February 12 U.S. District Court Judge Consuelo B. Marshall, Central District of California, entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Esther I. Lawrence, of Beverly Hills, California. Lawrence is the president and chief operating officer of Cardillo Travel Systems, Inc., a Los Angeles-based travel agency which previously had its stock listed on the American Stock Exchange.

Without admitting or denying the allegations of the Complaint, Lawrence consented to the Final Judgment which permanently enjoins her from violations of the antifraud and books and records provisions of the securities laws as well as from the filing provisions applicable to issuers. (SEC v. Cardillo Travel Systems, Inc., et al., Civil Action No. 87-4768, CBM, TX). (LR-11675)

PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST W. CARL ZIMMERMAN

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that on February 26 the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of California entered a Final Judgment permanently enjoining W. Carl Zimmerman from violating the registration provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the antifraud provisions of the Securities and Exchange Act of 1934. Zimmerman consented to the injunction without admitting or denying the allegations in the Commission's Complaint.

The September 3, 1986 Complaint alleged that from 1979 through at least March 1984, Zimmerman and Hugh F. Sackett directed and controlled the offer and sale of unregistered securities of American Principals Holdings Inc. (APHI) in the form of limited partnership interests and debentures in approximately 70 offerings which raised in excess of \$90 million from at least 2,500 investors. The Complaint further alleged that Zimmerman and Sackett caused APHI to make material misrepresentations and omissions concerning the actual use of investors' funds, in that, among other things, approximately \$10 million of investors' funds were loaned between certain limited partnerships and that APHI general partners and investors' funds were commingled among partnerships. (SEC v. W. Carl Zimmerman and Hugh F. Sackett, USDC SDCA, Civil Action No. 86-1846 N, CM). (LR-11676)

ADEL ADIB RIFFAT, OTHERS CONSENT TO INJUNCTIONS

On February 22 and March 2, Adel Adib Riffat, Joseph Kerherve, and Marhaba Overseas, S.A., without admitting or denying the allegations of a Complaint filed by the Commission on January 13 in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of New York: (1) consented to permanent injunctions against future violations; (2) agreed to disgorge a total of approximately \$25,000 in profits; and (3) agreed to pay an ITSA penalty equal to such profits. The Complaint alleges that the defendants violated the antifraud provisions of the Securities Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 by purchasing shares of Texas International Co. (TI) on February 4, 1985 while in possession of material non-public information concerning a significant oil strike by TI in Egypt. The Complaint further alleges that Kerherve and Adib learned of the oil strike by virtue of their positions with Schlumberger Logelco, Inc., a company that was retained by TI to provide certain exploratory and production tests for TI at the well site.

Simultaneously, the Commission sought and Judge Kevin T. Duffy granted a Temporary Restraining Order and certain other requested relief including a freeze of the defendants' assets. On January 20, due to the extraordinary efforts of the U.S. Department of State and the Egyptian authorities, the defendants, both foreign nationals residing in Cairo, Egypt, were served with process pursuant to the Haque Convention. (SEC v. Joseph Kerherve, et al., 88 Civ. 0227, KTD). (LR-11678)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

WESTERN LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 28 to request a hearing on an application filed by Western Life Insurance Company, Variable Account D of Western Life Insurance Company, and AMEV Investors, Inc. for an order granting exemptions from Sections 26(a)(2)(C) and 27(c)(2) of the Investment Company Act to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges in connection with the issuance of a variable annuity contract. (Rel. IC-16293 - Mar. 1)

THE ROYAL BANK OF SCOTLAND GROUP plc.

An order has been issued exempting The Royal Bank of Scotland from all provisions of the Investment Company Act so it may issue and sell debt and equity securities in the United States. (Rel. IC-16295 - Mar. 1)

MEDALLION FUNDING CORP.

An order has been issued exempting Medallion Funding Corp. from the provisions of Sections 8(b), 12(d)(1), 12(e), 17(a), 17(a), 18(a), 18(c), 30(b), and 30(d) of the Investment Company Act. (Rel. IC-16296 - Mar. 1)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the Depository Trust Company (SR-DTC-87-18) which extends the termination date on its Same-Day Funds Settlement Service, a temporary pilot program, from January 31 to June 30, 1988. (Rel. 34-25308)

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The MBS Clearing Corporation (SR-MCC-87-6) filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 to amend its Depository Division rules to provide for assessments of participants in certain cases and clarify its rights in connection with the financing of principal and interest payments. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of March 7. (Rel. 34-25410)
