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## RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

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### AMENDMENTS TO RULE 81 ADOPTED; FURTHER AMENDMENT PROPOSED

The Commission adopted amendments to Rule 81 under its regulations on Information and Requests concerning publication of interpretative, no-action and certain exemption correspondence with the staff. The amendments generally provide for prompt publication of such correspondence unless confidential treatment has been granted. Exceptions are made for correspondence regarding Exchange Act Rules 10b-6, 10b-7, 10b-8, 10b-13, and 13e-4, the trading practices rules, where correspondence will not be released until 30 days after the staff's response has been sent or given to the requesting party. In a companion release, the Commission is proposing a further amendment to Rule 81 that would provide for prompt publication of all correspondence subject to the rule, including trading practices correspondence. Comments should be submitted in triplicate to Jonathan G. Katz, Secretary, Securities and Exchange Commission, 450 Fifth Street, NW, Washington, DC 20549. Comments must be received 30 days from the date the release is published in the Federal Register and should refer to File No. S7-5-88. All submissions will be available for inspection in the Public Reference Room. (Rel. 33-6765)

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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### PERMANENT INJUNCTIONS ENTERED AGAINST WINDSOR EQUITY CORPORATION AND STEVEN E. WHITING

The Chicago Regional Office announced that on March 22 Judge Thomas J. Curran, Eastern District of Wisconsin, entered orders of permanent injunction against Windsor Equity Corporation and Steven E. Whiting, restraining them from further violations of the antifraud provisions of the securities laws, the net capital rule, the customer protection rule, and certain provisions of the books and records rules. Both consented to orders without admitting or denying the allegations of the Commission's Complaint. On March 21, the Court issued temporary restraining orders against the defendants and appointed a SIPC trustee to oversee the liquidation of Windsor.

The Complaint alleged that from at least July 1987 to the present, Windsor and Whiting misappropriated customer funds and made misrepresentations and omissions of material facts to customers concerning, among other things, the use of customer funds and that Windsor was conducting a securities business while insolvent.

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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### RUSSELL INSURANCE FUNDS, INC.

An order has been issued exempting Russell Insurance Funds, Inc. and Frank Russell Investment Management Company from the provisions of Section 15(a)(1) and Rule 18f-2, portions of Rule 20a-2, Items 5(b)(iii) and 16(a)(iii) of Form N-1A, Item 48 of Form N-SAR, and Section 6-07(2)(a), (b), and (c) of Regulation S-X. The order exempts them from (1) the requirement to disclose in the Funds' prospectuses, proxy statements, and other public documents the fees paid by Frank Russell Investment Management Company to discretionary investment portfolio managers otherwise unaffiliated with Applicants; and (2) the obligation to include in certain proxy statements the balance sheets of, and information concerning transactions in securities of, the otherwise unaffiliated discretionary investment managers. ### THE AMERICAN EXPRESS FUNDS

An order has been issued on an application filed by The American Express Funds (Funds) and American Express Service Corporation (American Express) approving certain offers of exchange among the present Funds and any future investment companies for which American Express serves as investment manager or distributor, and permitting the imposition of an administrative fee. 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## TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES

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### CITICORP HOMEOWNERS, INC.

An order has been issued under the Trust Indenture Act of 1939 on an application by Citicorp Homeowners, Inc. and Citicorp that the trusteeship of Mercantile Bank N.A. under an indenture and certain Pooling and Servicing Agreements of Applicants is not so likely to involve a material conflict of interest as to make it necessary in the public interest or for the protection of investors to disqualify the Bank from acting as trustee under either the indenture or the Agreements. Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
