### AMENDMENT TO RULE 2(e) ADOPTED

The Commission adopted an amendment to Rule 2(e) of the Commission's Rules of Practice providing that proceedings conducted under Rule 2(e) will be public unless the Commission, on its own motion or after considering the request of a party, otherwise orders. The amendment will be effective 30 days after publication in the Federal Register. (Rel. 33-6783)

### COMMENTS REQUESTED ON TWO ALTERNATIVE VERSIONS OF RULE 465

## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

---

### PERMANENT INJUNCTION ENTERED AGAINST OSCAR GOMEZ

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices announced that on June 24 U.S. District Judge William M. Hoeveler, Southern District of Florida, entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Oscar Gomez, of Coral Gables, Florida. Until February 1987, Gomez was a registered representative of a registered broker-dealer. The Final Judgment enjoins Gomez from violating the antifraud provisions of the Securities Act of 1933 and the antifraud and broker-dealer books and records provisions of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934. The Court retained jurisdiction for purposes of determining an amount to be disgorged by Gomez, if appropriate.

The April 25 Complaint alleges that Gomez and Michael W. Rehtorik, president of the broker-dealer, induced at least 22 investors to invest at least \$1.8 million through "managed trading account" agreements. The agreements provided that the funds would be used to invest in government securities, and that investors would receive interest at a specified annual rate. It also alleges that Gomez and Rehtorik were not investing the funds as represented but were instead misappropriating them. It further alleges that Gomez and Rehtorik caused the broker-dealer to make and keep current accurate books and records. (SEC v. Michael W. Rehtorik and Oscar Gomez, Civil Action No. 88-0735-CIV-HOEVELER, SDFL). (LR-11790)

## **CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS**

---

### **DAVID L. WILLIAMS SENTENCED**

The Boston Regional Office and the U.S. Attorney for the District of New Hampshire announced that on June 29 David L. Williams, of Manchester, New Hampshire, was sentenced to six years imprisonment. The indictment charged that Williams defrauded as many as 350 investment advisory clients of \$1.1 million. In April 1988, Williams pleaded guilty to three of 15 federal charges of mail and investment fraud.

The U.S. Attorney alleged that, among other things, Williams misrepresented to investors that their funds would be invested in Individual Retirement Accounts managed by a trust company while funds were actually used to pay the operating expenses of certain insolvent limited partnerships controlled by Williams.

In an earlier Commission action, Williams was enjoined from further violations of the registration, reporting, and antifraud provisions of the securities laws. The Commission also barred Williams from association with any broker, dealer, municipal securities dealer, investment company, or investment adviser. (U.S. v. David L. Williams, et al., Case No. 87-10-01-L, USDC DNH). (LR-11789)

## **INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

---

### **CRITERION ASSET BACKED INCOME FUND, INC.**

An order has been issued declaring that Criterion Asset Backed Income Fund, Inc. has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-16471 - July 6)

### **FG SERIES, INC.**

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 1 to request a hearing on an application filed by FG Series, Inc., an open-end management investment company which is a series company, and its distributor, Financial Programs, Inc., on behalf of themselves and other open-end registered investment companies distributed by Financial Programs which may be organized in the future. The application requests an order approving certain offers of exchange on a basis other than net asset value per share at the time of the exchange. (Rel. IC-16472 - July 6)

### **DREYFUS A BONDS PLUS, INC.**

## **HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES**

---

### **NATIONAL FUEL GAS COMPANY**

An order has been issued authorizing National Fuel Gas Company, a registered holding company, to issue and sell, through December 31, 1991 under an exception from competitive bidding, up to one million shares of authorized but unissued common stock, no par value, to shareholders participating in National's Dividend Reinvestment and Stock Purchase Plan, as amended (New Plan). By order dated June 9, 1988 [Rel. 35-24656], National was authorized to mail to each holder of record of its common stock a prospectus and an authorization form in connection with the solicitation of shareholders' participation in the New Plan. AMERICAN ELECTRIC POWER COMPANY, INC.

A supplemental order has been issued authorizing American Electric Power Company, Inc., a registered holding company, to increase capital contributions to its subsidiary, Columbus Southern Power Company, from \$25 million to \$40 million through December 31, 1988. (Rel. 35-24674 - July 7)

### ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission granted accelerated approval to proposed rule changes filed by the following to extend the market index option escrow receipt pilot program until October 31, 1988: Philadelphia, American, Pacific, and New York Stock Exchanges and the Chicago Board Options Exchange (SR-Phlx-87-5; SR-Amex-87-9; SR-PSE-87-21; SR-NYSE-87-40; and SR-CBOE-88-11). ### NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The National Association of Securities Dealers filed a proposed rule change under Rule 19b-4 (SR-NASD-88-25) to amend Sections 5(c) and 6 of Article V, Part A of its Code of Procedure to clarify that District Surveillance Committee action taken under Article V, Part A, Section 5(c) constitutes final action of the NASD which is reviewable by the Commission in contrast to written decisions issued under Sections 5(a) and 5(b) of Article V, Part A. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of July 5. (Rel. 34-25889)

### APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by The National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-87-1) to offer a new service consisting of a low-speed ticker displaying last sale reports for all NASDAQ/NMS securities and to set applicable fees. (Rel. 34-25890)
