CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

DEFENDANTS IN SPOKANE SCAM CONSENT TO INJUNCTIONS

The Seattle Regional Office announced that Judge Robert J. McNichols, U.S. District Court Judge in Spokane, Washington, entered Permanent Injunctions on October 27 against Image Productions, Inc., a Washington corporation, Robert Gilchrist and Michael Pallardy, both of Spokane, and on November 9 against Frankie Knight, also of Spokane.

The Injunctions prohibit Image Productions and Pallardy from further participation in the fraudulent offer and sale of Image Productions securities, and Gilchrist and Knight from further participation in the fraudulent offer and sale of Image Productions and other securities.

All four defendants consented to their Injunctions without admitting or denying the allegations. (SEC v. Joseph R. Edington, USDC EDWA, No. C-88-511-RJM). (LR-11918)

TOWERS CREDIT ENJOINED AND ORDERED TO OFFER RESCISSION

The New York Regional Office announced that on November 16 the U.S. District Court, Southern District of New York, issued a Final Consent Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Order against Towers Credit Corporation, Towers Financial Corp., Credit's parent, and Steven Hoffenberg, chairman and chief executive officer of both companies. The Judgment enjoins defendants, who consented while neither admitting nor denying Commission allegations, from violating the registration provisions of the securities laws. In a August 4 Complaint, the Commission alleged that the enjoined defendants sold over \$20 million of Credit's 18% promissory notes to over 400 investors located in 26 states, without complying with the registration provisions.

Additionally, the Judgment: (1) orders Credit and Financial to offer rescission to all note purchasers; (2) requires Credit to report about each and every sale of notes since the note distributions began in October 1986; (3) restrains defendants from using note proceeds other than to pay principal or interest on the notes or to purchase or finance accounts receivable, pending completion of the rescission; (4) requires Credit and Financial to post \$3.5 million as security for the rescission; and (5) prohibits destruction of records and requires Credit to supply to the Commission various records pertaining to the note program and Credit's factoring business. (SEC v. Towers Credit Corp., et al., 88 Civ. 5421, SWK, SDNY, August 4, 1988). (LR-11919)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE GUARDIAN GENERATION SERIES TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 13 to request a hearing on an application filed by The Guardian Generation Series Trust for an order declaring that it has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-16646 - Nov. 21)

CHEMICAL MORTGAGE ACCEPTANCE CORPORATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until December 13 to request a hearing on an application filed by Chemical Mortgage Acceptance Corporation for an order conditionally exempting it from all provisions of the Investment Company Act to permit it to sell collateralized mortgage obligations and residual interest certificates. HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

OCEAN STATE POWER; CENTRAL COAL COMPANY

Notices have been issued giving interested persons until December 12 to request a hearing on a proposal by the following companies filed under Release 35-24749, dated November 17: OCEAN STATE POWER (OSP) - a general partnership and subsidiary of EUA Ocean State Corporation (EUA-OS) and Narragansett Energy Resources Company (NERC), and its indirect parent companies, Eastern Utilities Associates (EUA) and New England Electric System (NEES), and Blackstone Valley Electric Company, subsidiary of EUA, whereby OSP proposes to issue non-recourse notes in a principal amount of approximately \$240 million to a syndicate of financial institutions under a seven-year credit facility, with performance guarantees from EUA and NEES regarding the respective obligations of EUA-OS and NERC to make equity investments in OSP, and issue an additional principal amount of \$6 million of such non-recourse notes to the same syndicate, not supported by such guarantees from EUA and NEES, to be used to construct certain interconnection facilities, which will be acquired by Blackstone; and CENTRAL COAL COMPANY - subsidiary of Appalachian Power Company and Ohio Power Company, to pay to Appalachian and Ohio a dividend, not to exceed \$2,325,000, to be paid out of additional paid-in capital.

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

ACCELERATED APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission granted accelerated approval to a proposed rule change filed by the Pacific Stock Exchange (SR-PSE-88-25) to provide greater flexibility in the establishment of position and exercise limits for stock options. (Rel. 34-26297)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by the New York Stock Exchange (SR-NYSE-88-21) that would adopt Rule 750A. The proposed rule would regulate option specialist performance evaluation and reallocation procedures and would be implemented on a pilot basis to run concurrently with the existing pilot program for NYSE Rule 103A. (Rel. 34-26298)
