NOTICE OF COMMISSION MEETINGS

Following is a schedule of Commission meetings which will be conducted under provisions of the Government in the Sunshine Act. In general, the Commission expects to follow a schedule of holding closed meetings on Tuesdays, and open meetings on Thursday morning. Meetings on Wednesday, and if necessary on Thursday afternoons, will be either open or closed according to the requirements of agenda items under consideration.

Visitors are welcome at all open meetings, insofar as space is available.

Meetings will be held in the Commission Meeting Room, Room 1C30, at the Commission's headquarters building, 450 Fifth Street, NW, Washington, DC. Persons wishing to photograph or videotape Commission meetings must obtain permission in advance from the Secretary of the Commission. Persons wishing to tape record a Commission meeting should notify the Secretary's office 48 hours in advance of the meeting.

The subject matter of the January 18 closed meeting will be: Settlement of injunctive actions; Institution of administrative proceedings of an enforcement nature; Settlement of administrative proceedings of an enforcement nature; Formal orders of investigation.

OPEN MEETING - THURSDAY, JANUARY 19, 1989 - 10:00 a.m.

The subject matter of the January 19 open meeting will be:

(1) Consideration of whether to propose for public comment Rule 17 and amendments to Rule 2 and Form U-3A-2 under the Public Utility Holding Company Act of 1935. Rule 17 would specify the circumstances in which non-utility diversification by an intrastate public-utility holding company would not be deemed detrimental to the public interest or the interest of investors or consumers. Amended Rule 2 would provide that a claim of exemption under Rule 2 by an intrastate public-utility holding company, in order to be effective, would require the holding company to meet one of the safe harbor provisions of Rule 17, and amended Form U-3A-2 would require the company to furnish information supporting its ability to rely on one of the safe harbor provisions of Rule 17. (2) Consideration of whether to adopt amendments to Forms N-3 and N-4 to (a) require consolidation of all expense-related information in a fee table located near the front of each variable annuity separate account prospectus; and (b) eliminate disclosure that would be repetitive of information contained in the fee table. In addition, the Commission will consider whether to adopt amendments to Form N-1A to eliminate the fee table requirement for management investment companies offering shares exclusively to separate accounts. (3) Consideration of whether to publish a release for comment which proposes amendments to Rule 10b-4. The proposed amendments would clarify the net long proviso of the rule. LEGG MASON CASH RESERVE TRUST

The Commission temporarily approved a proposed rule change filed by the Midwest Stock Exchange (SR-MSE-88-7) to adopt a pilot program for the automatic execution of "stopped, out-of-range" orders on a "next sale, but no better than last sale" basis. (Rel. 34-26430)

APPROVAL OF PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Commission approved a proposed rule change filed by The Cincinnati Stock Exchange (SR-CSE-88-4) to limit its liability for Exchange member and member organization use of CSE facilities. (Rel. 34-26431); and The National Association of Securities Dealers (SR-NASD-88-36) to amend Part III of Schedule D to its By-Laws to modify the eligibility criteria for NASDAQ National Market system securities and to add a requirement for shareholder approval of certain issuer transactions.
