INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

TEMPLETON GROWTH AND TREASURY TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until March 12, 1990 to request a hearing on an application filed by Templeton Growth and Treasury Trust, Series 1 and Subsequent Series (the Trust), Templeton, Galbraith & Hansberger, Ltd., Templeton Funds Distributor, Inc., Clayton Brown & Associates, Inc., and by and on behalf of the open-end investment companies (other than money market or no-load funds) which are advised by Templeton, Galbraith & Hansberger, Ltd. or principally underwritten by Templeton Funds Distributor, Inc. Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
