COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

COMMISSION TO CONSIDER PROPOSED RULE 144A, PORTAL, AND REGULATION S

Chairman Richard C. Breeden today announced that the Commission will hold an open meeting on April 19 at 10:00 a.m. to consider adoption of proposed Rule 144A, the National Association of Securities Dealers' proposed rule change (PORTAL Rules) relating to the PORTAL system, and proposed Regulation S. (Press Release 90-16)

CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

COMPLAINT NAMES PEGASUS ENTREPRENEURIAL VENTURES, DAVID W. BROWN

The Denver Regional Office announced the filing of a complaint on March 14 against Pegasus Entrepreneurial Ventures, Inc., a Colorado corporation, and David W. Brown of Salt Lake City, its president and sole shareholder, enjoining them from future violations of the antifraud and registration provisions of the federal securities laws.

The complaint alleged violations of Sections 17(a), 5(a) and 5(c) of the Securities Act and Sections 10(b) and 15(a) of the Securities Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5, based on allegations that Pegasus and Brown offered and sold contracts for investments in gold. The complaint also alleged that in the offer and sale of these securities, defendants misstated and omitted material facts concerning: the gold content, production and condition of Pegasus' mine; the return investors were to expect and the period of time over which that return would occur; the risks associated with the investment; and the use of investor proceeds.

The Colorado Division of Securities provided substantial assistance in the investigation. [SEC v. Pegasus Entrepreneurial Ventures, Inc., et al., U.S.D.C. Co., Civ. Action No. 90-C-427] (LR-12421)

CRIMINAL PROCEEDINGS

PENNY STOCK PROMOTOR'S BOND REVOKED

The Atlanta Regional and Miami Branch Offices and the U.S. Attorney, Southern District of Florida, announced that bond for James A. Lailaona (Lailaona) was revoked following a March 15 hearing before a U.S. Magistrate in West Palm Beach, Florida. Lailaona's bond was originally set at \$300,000 in February 1990, following the return of a fifteen-count indictment charging Lailaona with securities fraud, mail fraud, and acting as a broker-dealer while not registered as such with the Commission.

Lailaona's bond was revoked based on (1) the magistrate's finding that Lailaona was untruthful in responding to questions at the February 12 bond hearing regarding his business affiliations and use of aliases in business dealings; and (2) Lailaona's violations of the terms of his release by allegedly engaging in illegal activities while free on bond in connection with a matter being prosecuted by the U.S. Attorney's Office in Philadelphia. Lailaona is currently incarcerated in Miami, Florida.

The Commission filed a civil injunctive action against Lailaona and others on December 8, 1989, alleging that Lailaona aided and abetted or violated the transfer agent, antifraud and registration provisions of the securities laws. [United States v. James A. Lailaona, Indictment No. 90-6030-Cr-Roettger, U.S.D.C. S.D. FL] (LR-12422)

ROBERT C. GLEAVE SENTENCED

The Denver Regional and Salt Lake City Branch Offices and the U.S. Attorney for the District of Utah announced that on March 13 Robert C. Gleave was sentenced to ten months' incarceration and ordered to pay \$5,000 in restitution by U.S. District Court Judge J. Thomas Greene.

Gleave earlier pled guilty to two counts of a thirty-six-count indictment which charged Gleave with conspiracy, securities fraud, and wire fraud. Gleave admitted that he met with undercover F.B.I. agents to plot the illegal manipulated trades of the stock of Protecto Industries, Inc. and that, as a registered representative employed by XCEL Securities, Inc., he arranged to have Protecto listed in the National Daily Quotation Bureau, Inc.'s "pink sheets." Gleave further admitted that he was paid \$5,000 for his part in the scheme.

Protecto was part of an F.B.I. undercover operation that has resulted in the entry of guilty pleas to felony and misdemeanor informations by eleven persons. Protecto was fraudulently made into a public vehicle and had fabricated assets of nearly \$1 million. [United States v. Robert C. Gleave, U.S.D.C. Utah C.D., Cr. Action No. 89-CR-0015G] (LR-12423)

GENERAL PUBLIC UTILITIES CORPORATION

An order has been issued authorizing General Public Utilities Corporation (GPU) to issue and reacquire upon any forfeiture, from time to time through December 31, 1995, up to one million shares of common stock (\$2.50 par) under a 1990 Stock Plan for Employees of General Public Utilities Corporation and Subsidiaries (Plan). GPU also requests authority to solicit from its stockholders proxies for use at the 1990 Annual Meeting of Stockholders with respect to approval of (i) the Plan and (ii) an amendment to a prior plan, GPU's Restrictive Stock Plan (Restrictive Stock Plan) for outside directors, for which authority has been granted by order dated March 30, 1989 (Rel. 35-24851) to provide that each director of GPU participating in that plan shall automatically receive a fixed annual award of 100 shares of common stock under the Restrictive Stock Plan rather than such number of shares, if any, as might be determined by the Restrictive Stock Plan's administrative committee.
