## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

### INJUNCTIVE ACTION AGAINST ROBERT LEWIS AND JAMES BECKETT

The Chicago Regional Office filed a complaint in the U.S. District Court for the Southern District of Florida seeking to preliminarily and permanently enjoin Robert Gary Lewis a.k.a. Robert Stone and James Beckett of the Fort Lauderdale, Florida area from further violations of the antifraud, registration and record-keeping provisions of the federal securities laws. The complaint alleges, in part, that in connection with the offer and sale of Sheppard Resources, Inc. securities, that Lewis and Beckett failed to disclose, among other things, material information about Sheppard's control, officers and directors, the status and financial condition of a potential merger partner for Sheppard, and the fact that Sheppard was a blind pool. ### FINAL JUDGMENT ENTERED AGAINST JACK N. POLEVOI

The Los Angeles Regional Office announced that, on September 18, U.S. District Judge Robert J. Kelleher entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction, Disgorgement, and Imposition of Civil Penalties Against Defendant Jack N. Polevoi. The Final Judgment was entered following the Court's granting of the Commission's renewed Motion for Summary Judgment against Jack Polevoi on September 17, 1990. The Commission's Motion for Summary Judgment was based on the undisputed facts that Jack Polevoi was a corporate officer and insider of ZZZZ Best Co., Inc. (Z Best), and that between June 29 and July 1, 1987, Jack Polevoi caused 54,200 shares of Z Best stock to be sold short while he possessed material nonpublic information. Judge Kelleher permanently enjoined Jack Polevoi from further violations of Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, ordered that he disgorge \$224,860.75 in ill-gotten gains plus prejudgment interest, and ordered that he pay a triple penalty of \$674,582.25 pursuant to the Insider Trading Sanctions Act of 1984.

Jack Polevoi had pled guilty on June 9, 1988, to an indictment that included a charge that he had conspired to commit violations of the Securities Exchange Act. He was previously incarcerated for the crimes to which he pled guilty. [SEC v. Jack N. Polevoi, et al., Civil Action No. 89-1001 RJK (Sx) (C.D. Cal.)] (LR-12631)

## PERMANENT INJUNCTION AND DISGORGEMENT ORDER AGAINST MICHAEL WRIGHT

The Honorable Milton I. Shadur, U.S. District Court Judge for the Northern District of Illinois entered an Order of Disgorgement and a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction against Michael Wright. The Order requires Wright to disgorge ill-gotten gains in the form of a one-half interest in a ranch he owns near Park City, Utah to the U.S. government for subsequent sale. The proceeds of the sale will be paid into the registry of the Court in Chicago. The other one-half interest had been previously forfeited to the U.S. government pursuant to an order entered in the Nevada U.S. District Court. The Final Judgment enjoins Wright from further violations of the anti-fraud provisions of the federal securities laws and from aiding and abetting violations of the bookkeeping provisions of the federal securities laws. Additionally, Wright is ordered to cooperate fully with the Commission in connection with its further prosecution and investigation of this and related matters. [SEC v.
