SEC TO HOLD ROUNDTABLE ON CLEARANCE AND SETTLEMENT

The Commission today announced that it will hold a Roundtable on Clearance and Settlement on Tuesday, November 27, from 9:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. in the Commission Meeting Room, Room 1C30, 450 Fifth Street, N.W., Washington, D.C.

The purpose of the Roundtable is for representatives of the financial community and other interested persons to express their views on implementation of proposals to improve the process of clearance and settlement of securities transactions. These proposals include shortening the settlement cycle from five business days after the trade date to three business days, and using same-day funds instead of next-day funds for settlement. CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

CONTEMPT ORDER ENTERED AGAINST WILLIAM CLARK

The Fort Worth Regional Office announced that on November 6 the Honorable Barefoot Sanders, U.S. District Judge, Northern District of Texas, Dallas Division, entered a Judgment of Civil Contempt against William B. Clark for failing to comply with an Order of Disgorgement entered against him on August 1, 1990 in which Clark was ordered to disgorge into the registry of the Court \$218,610 plus postjudgment interest. Clark failed to respond or comply to the Disgorgement Order and also failed to appear before Judge Sanders at a scheduled show cause hearing pursuant to an order entered on October 17, 1990. The Commission has asked that Clark be incarcerated for contempt and Judge Sanders has reserved his decision regarding contempt sanctions pending a report to be filed on November 20, 1990. [SEC v. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

T. ROWE PRICE CALIFORNIA TAX-FREE TRUST

A conditional order has been issued under Section 17(d) of the Investment Company Act and Rule 17d-1 thereunder on an application filed by T. Rowe Price California Tax-Free Trust, et al. The order permits certain investment companies to participate in joint accounts designed to pool cash balances and reserves. (Rel. IC-17859 - November 16)

SELF-REGULATORY ORGANIZATIONS

PROPOSED RULE CHANGE

The Pacific Stock Exchange filed a proposed rule change (SR-PSE-90-37) pursuant to Rule 19b-4 of the Securities Exchange Act to amend the Exchange's listing standards for the listing of common stock on the Exchange and to make a minor amendment to its maintenance standards for the continued listing of securities on the Exchange. Publication of the proposal is expected to be made in the Federal Register during the week of November 19. (Rel. 34-28624)

ACQUISITION OF SECURITIES

Companies and individuals must report to the Commission within ten days on Schedule 13D if after the acquisition of equity securities of a public company their beneficial interest therein exceeds five percent. Persons eligible to use the short form (Schedule 13G) may in lieu of filing a Schedule 13D file a Schedule 13G within 45 days after the end of the calendar year in which the person became subject to Section 13(d)(1). Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.

Below is a list of recent filings of Schedules 13D and 14D, which includes the following information: Column 1 - the company purchased (top), and the name of the purchaser; Column 2 - the type of security purchased; Column 3 - the type of form filed; Column 4 - the date the transaction occurred; Column 5 - the current number of shares (in 000's) owned (top) and the current percent owned; Column 6 - the CUSIP number (top) and the percent owned; and Column 7 - the status of the filing, i.e., new, update or revision.
