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## NOTICE OF COMMISSION MEETINGS

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## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

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### BRUCE BLACK PERMANENTLY BARRED

The Commission issued Findings and an Order Imposing Remedial Sanctions by Default (Default Order) against Bruce Black (Black), of Wantagh, New York, which permanently bars him from association with any broker or dealer. Black failed to answer the Order Instituting Proceedings and, therefore, was found to be in default.

The Default Order states that Black willfully violated Sections 5(a) and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 (Securities Act), Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 (Exchange Act) and Rule 10b-5 thereunder, and that he willfully aided and abetted violations of Section 15(a)(1) of the Exchange Act. The Default Order states that from May 1988 through April 1989, Black misappropriated funds from customers who had given money to invest in various securities, and from January 1989 through March 1989, misappropriated additional money through the fraudulent sale of unregistered securities. The Default Order also states that in or around April 1989, Black aided and abetted violations of the broker-dealer registration provisions by D.L. Cabot, Inc., an entity Black co-founded, which operated as an unregistered broker-dealer.

The Default Order further states that on October 11, 1990, a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Discovery against Black by default was issued by the Honorable Jack B. Weinstein, U.S. District Judge, Eastern District of New York, enjoining him from committing or aiding and abetting violations of Sections 5(a) and 17(a) of the Securities Act, Sections 15(a)(1) and 10(b) of the Exchange Act, and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. ## SANCTIONS IMPOSED ON V.F. MINTON SECURITIES AND VERNON MINTON

Judge Brenda P. Murray has ordered the revocation of the broker-dealer registration of V.F. Minton Securities, Inc., of Fort Worth, Texas, and has barred Vernon F. Minton from being associated with any broker or dealer. Respondents willfully and knowingly violated the antifraud and registration provisions of the securities statutes in 1989 when they sold and distributed approximately half a million shares of U.S. Assurance, a company allegedly authorized to issue insurance. 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## CIVIL PROCEEDINGS

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### ANTHONY TAVANI SETTLES CIVIL INJUNCTIVE ACTION

The New York Regional Office announced today the filing of a civil action in New York against Anthony R. Tavani (Tavani) arising from his June 1990 purchase of General Instrument Corp. (General Instrument) securities while in possession of material non-public information relating to a leveraged buyout of General Instrument by Forstmann Little & Co. Simultaneously with the filing of the complaint, without admitting or denying the allegations, Tavani consented to the entry of a Final Judgment permanently enjoining him from violating Sections 10(b) and 14(e) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rules 10b-5 and 14e-3 thereunder. Tavani further agreed to disgorge \$10,805.31, the amount he realized as a result of his unlawful trading, plus pre-judgment interest. He also agreed to pay \$10,805.31 as a penalty under the Insider Trading and Securities Fraud Enforcement Act of 1988. Tavani sold his stock shortly after the July 2, 1990 public announcement.
