## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS

### DECISION BARRING ALLEN ASKER FROM ASSOCIATION WITH ANY BROKER OR DEALER FINAL

The decision of an administrative law judge barring Allen R. Asker of Dana Point, California and Logan, Utah from association with any broker or dealer has become final. After two years, Asker may apply to become so associated in a non-proprietary and non-supervisory capacity upon a satisfactory showing to the Commission that he will be adequately supervised.

Asker was a registered representative with the Los Angeles office of Bear, Stearns & Company. The law judge found that in 1987 Asker violated registration and antifraud provisions of the securities laws in connection with his offer and sale of securities of Phoenix Aviation, Inc. Asker made material misrepresentations to investors concerning Phoenix's financial condition, the status of its manufacturing activities, the projected value of its securities and his own guarantee against loss. He failed to disclose the corporation's precarious financial and operational condition. In 1990, a permanent injunction was issued against Asker, with his consent, based on the same misconduct. ## ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDINGS AGAINST KEITH BAITY

The Commission instituted public administrative proceedings against Keith Baity (Baity), a former registered representative of Bear Stearns & Co., Inc., under the Securities Act of 1934 (Securities Act). Simultaneously, the Commission accepted Baity's Offer of Settlement. The Commission found that Baity was enjoined from violating Section 10(b) of the Securities Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder in SEC v. Keith Baity [92 Civ. 1672, LBS, judgment entered March 12, 1992], a case involving insider trading. The Commission's Order bars Baity from association with any broker, dealer, investment adviser, investment company or municipal securities dealer with a right to reapply after five years. ## COMMISSION ISSUES STOP ORDER SUSPENDING EFFECTIVENESS OF FORM S-18 FILED BY CROSS RESEARCH CORP.

The Commission issued a stop order suspending the effectiveness of a registration statement filed on Form S-18 by Cross Research Corp. (Cross Research) pursuant to an Order Instituting Proceedings Pursuant to Section 8(d) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Findings and Stop Order. The Commission found that Cross Research's Form S-18 contained untrue statements and omissions of material facts, including, inter alia, misrepresentations that the officers and directors were its founders or organizers when, in fact, the disclosed officers and directors were nominees and omissions of the identity of its true founders and organizers. The Form S-18 also contained misrepresentations that its officers and directors gave consideration in cash and services in exchange for stock when, in fact, no consideration was given and omissions that the signature of one of its designated directors on the Form S-18 was forged or otherwise affixed without her consent.

The Commission determined to accept Cross Research's Offer of Settlement in which it neither admitted nor denied the Commission's findings and agreed to the stop order suspending the effectiveness of the Form S-18. (Rel. 33-6929)

## COMMISSION ISSUES STOP ORDER SUSPENDING EFFECTIVENESS OF FORM S-18 FILED BY IRVING TECHNOLOGY, INC.

The Commission issued a stop order suspending the effectiveness of a registration statement filed on Form S-18 by Irving Technology, Inc. (Irving Technology) pursuant to an Order Instituting Proceedings Pursuant to Section 8(d) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Findings and Stop Order. The Commission found that Irving Technology's Form S-18 contained untrue statements and omissions of material facts, including, inter alia, misrepresentations that the officers and directors were its founders or organizers when, in fact, the disclosed officers and directors were nominees and omissions of the identity of its true founders and organizers. The Form S-18 also contained misrepresentations that its officers and directors gave consideration in cash and services in exchange for stock when, in fact, no consideration was given and omissions that the signature of one of its designated directors on the Form S-18 was forged or otherwise affixed without her consent.

The Commission determined to accept Irving Technology's Offer of Settlement in which it neither admitted nor denied the Commission's findings and agreed to the stop order suspending the effectiveness of the Form S-18. (Rel. 33-6930)

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## INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### ISI GROWTH FUND, INC. ISI TRUST FUND

Orders have been issued under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that ISI Growth Fund, Inc. and ISI Trust Fund have ceased to be investment companies. (Rel. IC-18626 and IC-18627, respectively - March 24)

### PATRIOT PRIVATE DIVIDEND TERM TRUST

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until April 20 to request a hearing on an application filed by Patriot Private Dividend Term Trust for an order under Section 8(f) of the Investment Company Act declaring that applicant has ceased to be an investment company. (Rel. IC-18631 - March 26)

### C.M. LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act exempting C.M. Life Insurance Company, Panorama Plus Separate Account (Account) and G.R. Phelps & Co., Inc. from the provisions of Sections 26(a)(2) and 27(c)(2) of the Act. The exemptions apply to the extent necessary to permit the deduction of mortality and expense risk charges from the assets of the Account under certain variable annuity contracts. (Rel. IC-18632 - March 26)

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## HOLDING COMPANY ACT RELEASES

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### OLS ENERGY-BERKELEY

An order has been issued authorizing OLS Energy-Berkeley, an indirect subsidiary company of General Public Utilities Corporation, a registered holding company, to borrow under its Credit Agreement and Note until December 31, 1992. (Rel. 35-25501)

### TRANSOK, INC.

An order has been issued authorizing Transok, Inc., a subsidiary company of Central and South West Corporation, a registered holding company, to issue and sell up to \$200 million aggregate principal amount of its medium-term notes from time to time through December 31, 1993. (Rel. 35-25502)

**TRUST INDENTURE ACT RELEASES**

PUBLIC SERVICE ELECTRIC AND GAS COMPANY

The Commission has issued an order under the Trust Indenture Act on an application by Public Service Electric and Gas Company (Company) exempting from the provisions of Section 316(a)(1) of the Act certain First and Refunding Mortgage Bonds (Bonds) under an indenture dated as of August 1, 1924, as amended by the Supplemental Indenture dated as of March 1, 1942. The amended indenture between the Company and Fidelity Union Trust Company (now First Fidelity Bank, National Association, New Jersey) as Trustee (Indenture) will be supplemented by a separate supplemental indenture providing for each series of Bonds to be dated the first day of the month in which each such series of Bonds is issued. The Bonds are of the character referred to in Section 314(c)(1) and are outstanding on January 1, 1959. Compliance with the provisions of Section 316(a)(1) of the Act with respect to the percentages of holders specified in specified Sections of the Indenture, as supplemented, would require by reason of the provisions of such Indenture, as supplemented, the consent of the holders of securities outstanding thereunder. Companies and individuals making a tender offer must have on file at the time the tender offer commences a Schedule 14D-1.
