COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENT

COMMISSION EXTENDS DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION OF MATERIALS FOR SEPTEMBER 20 HEARING

The Securities and Exchange Commission late yesterday extended to September 12, 2000 the deadline by which the Commission must receive copies of oral statements or summaries of testimony by those requesting to testify at the September 20, 2000 public hearing on auditor independence. The date by which the Commission must receive materials for the September 13 hearing remains September 5, 2000.

RULES AND RELATED MATTERS

COMMISSION APPROVES RULE THAT PERMITS EXCHANGES TO TRADE IPOs PURSUANT TO UNLISTED TRADING PRIVILEGES ON FIRST DAY OF TRADING

On August 29, the Commission adopted an amendment to Rule 12f-2 under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 concerning unlisted trading privileges (UTP) in listed initial public offerings (IPOs). Under the amendment, a national securities exchange extending UTP to an IPO security listed on another exchange will no longer be required to wait until the day after trading has begun on the listing exchange to allow trading in that security. Instead, a national securities exchange will be permitted to begin trading an IPO issue immediately after the first trade in the security is reported to the Consolidated Tape by the listing exchange. ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

COURT ENTERS FINAL JUDGMENT AGAINST JOHN TRIMPIN IN SPECIALIZED MOBILE RADIO FRAUD

The Commission announced that on August 7 the Honorable Colleen Kollar-Kotelly, United States District Court Judge for the District of Columbia, entered a Final Judgment of Permanent Injunction and Other Relief as to John C. Trimpin. The final judgment ordered Trimpin to pay \$266,800 in disgorgement, \$155,876 in prejudgment interest and a \$266,800 penalty. The judgment holds Trimpin jointly and severally liable with other defendants previously enjoined in the case and held liable for Trimpin's amounts of disgorgement, interest and penalty. The Court found that the disgorgement amount represented the amount of investor funds received by Trimpin as a result of his unlawful conduct.

Trimpin admitted the allegations against him contained in the Commission's complaint and consented to the entry of the Final Judgment. According to the complaint, which was filed on March 2, 1999, Trimpin and other defendants engaged in fraud in connection with the offer and sale to the public of securities designated as partnership units in three general partnerships formed to develop specialized mobile radio systems in Albany, New York, Reno, Nevada and Anchorage, Alaska. The complaint alleges that Trimpin and other defendants managed the fund-raising and operations of the three partnerships, and disseminated sales materials that contained material misrepresentations and omissions. The complaint further alleges that Trimpin and other defendants controlled the specialized mobile radio licenses. These defendants failed to disclose this control and the sale of the licenses to the partnerships at enormously excessive prices. The Court enjoined Trimpin from violating the securities registration provisions of Sections 5(a)

and (c) of the Securities Act and the antifraud provisions of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act and Section 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder. COMMISSION FILES LAWSUIT AGAINST TUTORNET.COM GROUP, INC. AND EUBURN FORDE

On August 29, the Commission filed an injunctive action against Tutornet.com Group, Inc. of Chantilly, Virginia, and Euburn R.A. Forde, Tutornet's president, chief executive officer and chairman of the board. The Commission's complaint alleges that Tutornet and Forde made false and misleading statements, and omitted to state material information, in a Form 8-K filed with the Commission on May 18, 2000, and in a January 2000 letter to shareholders published on Tutornet's website, in an effort to lull current and prospective investors into a false sense of security in the face of Tutornet's precarious financial condition. The complaint also alleges that Tutornet's Form 10-Q filed with the Commission on August 21, 2000 was deficient because it failed to include a statement of cash flow. The Commission also filed with the complaint a motion for a preliminary injunction against Tutornet and Forde.

The complaint alleges that Tutornet and Forde violated Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 10b-5 thereunder; that Tutornet violated Section 13(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 12b-20, 13a-11 and 13a-13 thereunder; and that Forde aided and abetted Tutornet's violations of Section 13(a) of the Exchange Act and Rules 12b-20, 13a-11 and 13a-13 thereunder. The Commission's complaint seeks civil injunctions against both Tutornet and Forde and the imposition of civil penalties against them. [SEC v. Tutornet.com Group, Inc. and Euburn R.A. SILICON VALLEY EMPLOYEE CHARGED WITH INSIDER TRADING

The Commission filed a complaint in the Northern District of California on August 29 against Manu B. Shrivastava, 31, a former engineer at nVIDIA Corporation. The Commission's complaint alleges that, while still employed by nVIDIA, Shrivastava engaged in illegal insider trading when he purchased nearly \$31,000 worth of nVIDIA call options. According to the complaint, Shrivastava's purchase was based on his advance knowledge that nVIDIA had just won a lucrative contract with Microsoft Corporation. Within days, the price of nVIDIA stock soared as the market learned of the contract, and Shrivastava sold his options, realizing unlawful profits of approximately \$446,724. nVIDIA is headquartered in Santa Clara, California.

In its complaint, the Commission seeks a permanent injunction against future violations, disgorgement, and civil penalties for insider trading. [SEC v. Manu v. Shrivastava,

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MPAM FUNDS TRUST

An order has been issued on an application filed by MPAM Funds Trust under Section 12(d)(1)(J) of the Investment Company Act for an exemption from Section 12(d)(1)(G)(i)(II) of the Act. The order permits a fund of funds relying on Section 12(d)(1)(G) of the Act to invest in securities and other financial instruments. (Rel. IC-24624 – August 29)

WELLS FARGO FUNDS TRUST, ET AL.

An order has been issued on an application filed by Wells Fargo Funds Trust, et al., exempting applicants from Section 15(f)(1)(A) of the Investment Company Act. Without the requested exemption, certain investment companies advised by Wells Fargo Bank, N.A. (Wells Fargo) would have to reconstitute their respective boards of trustees to meet the 75 percent non-interested director requirement of Section 15(f)(1)(A) of the Act in order for Wells Fargo to rely upon the safe harbor provisions of Section 15(f). PROPOSED RULE CHANGES

The Philadelphia Stock Exchange has filed a proposed rule change (SR-Phlx-00-02) under Rule 19b-4 of the Exchange Act to amend its Certificate of Incorporation to authorize the issuance of trading permits. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of August 28. (Rel. 34-43211)

The Philadelphia Stock Exchange has filed a proposed rule change (SR-Phlx-00-03) under Rule 19b-4 of the Exchange Act relating to the issuance of Equity Trading Permits. Publication of the proposal is expected in the Federal Register during the week of August 28. (Rel. 34-43212)

The Philadelphia Stock Exchange has filed a proposed rule change (SR-Phlx-00-04) under Rule 19b-4 of the Exchange Act imposing an application fee, initiation fee and monthly fee for Equity Trading Permits. Publication of the notice in the Federal Register is expected during the week of August 28. (Rel. 34-43213)
