COMMISSION ANNOUNCEMENTS

PUBLICATION OF STAFF LEGAL BULLETIN NO. 11

On September 19, 2000, the Division of Investment Management issued a staff legal bulletin on the applicability of the Investment Advisers Act of 1940 to financial advisors of issuers of municipal securities. The bulletin clarifies the circumstances under which financial advisors may advise issuers of municipal securities on the investment of their bond offering proceeds without being deemed to be investment advisers. The bulletin also explains when financial advisors may advise their clients about investments in specific money market accounts without being subject to the Advisers Act.

OPEN MEETING – THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 28, 2000 – 2:00 P.M.

The subject matter of the open meeting scheduled for Thursday, September 28, at 2:00 p.m. will be:

The Commission will hear oral argument on an appeal by the Division of Enforcement and the Office of the Chief Accountant from an initial decision of an administrative law judge in the matter of KPMG Peat Marwick LLP (Peat Marwick).

This case involves allegations that certain circumstances impaired Peat Marwick's independence from an audit client, Porta Systems Corp. (PORTA). The law judge found that only one of these circumstances -- Peat Marwick's loan to PORTA's president -- impaired Peat Marwick's independence. Because generally accepted auditing standards (GAAS) require that auditors be independent from audit clients, the law judge concluded that Peat Marwick violated the requirement in Rule 2-02 of Regulation S-X that an accountant's report accurately "state whether the audit was made in accordance" with GAAS. The law judge also concluded that, because Peat Marwick was not independent at the time it certified financial statements filed by PORTA as part of its 1995 annual report, Peat Marwick caused PORTA to violate Section 13(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 13a-1 thereunder. The law judge did not conclude, however, that Peat Marwick had engaged in improper professional conduct within the meaning of Rule 102(e) of the Commission's Rules of Practice. The law judge dismissed the proceeding insofar as it alleged that Peat Marwick engaged in improper professional conduct under Rule 102(e) and denied the Division's request for entry of a cease and desist order against Peat Marwick under Section 21C of the Exchange Act.

Among the issues likely to be argued are the following:

1. whether Peat Marwick's loan to PORTA's president was the only independence impairing circumstance involved in this case;
2. whether Peat Marwick acted recklessly with respect to any independence impairing circumstances involved in this case; and
3. whether, and what, sanctions are appropriate remedies in this case.

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

SEC BRINGS FRAUD CHARGES IN INTERNET MANIPULATION SCHEME

Settlement Calls for Return of \$285,000 in Illegal Gains

The Commission today brought and settled civil fraud charges against Jonathan G. Lebed, age 15, for using the Internet to conduct a stock manipulation scheme that made total profits of \$272,826. Without admitting or denying the findings, Mr. Lebed settled with the Commission, agreeing to an administrative cease and desist order and to disgorge his illegal profits of \$272,826, together with prejudgment interest of \$12,174, for a total of \$285,000. This is the first time the Commission has brought charges against a minor.

Ronald C. Long, Administrator of the Philadelphia District Office said, "I implore investors to be highly skeptical of any advice they receive from the Internet. People should do thorough research before making investment decisions and verify all information before acting on it."

The Commission's Order finds that, on eleven separate occasions between August 23, 1999 (when Lebed was 14 years old) and February 4, 2000, Lebed, of Cedar Grove, New Jersey, engaged in a scheme on the Internet in which he purchased, through brokerage accounts, a large block of a thinly-traded microcap stock. Within hours of making the purchase, Lebed sent numerous false and/or misleading unsolicited e-mail messages, or "spam," primarily to various Yahoo! Finance message boards, touting the stock he had just purchased. Lebed then sold all of these shares, usually within 24 hours, profiting from the increase in price his messages had caused. In some instances, Lebed placed a sell limit order before the market closed on the day he purchased the stock to ensure that he would not miss the price increase of the stock while he was in school the next day. Lebed's profits on each trade ranged from more than \$11,000 to nearly \$74,000.

The Order finds that Lebed used multiple fictitious author names for the hundreds of identical messages he posted during each manipulation. The postings Lebed made to Internet website message boards included baseless price predictions and other false and/or misleading statements. For example, he claimed in one of his messages that a

company trading at \$2 per share would be trading at more than \$20 per share "very soon." Other postings claimed that a stock would be the "next stock to gain 1,000%," and was "the most undervalued stock ever." The posted messages always caused the price and volume of the touted stocks to increase dramatically. On the day that Lebed sold his shares, and realized his profit, the trading volume in the stock reached either record or near-record highs, in some cases reaching a 52-week high for both volume and price. CORRECTION

The following is a corrected summary for an item that appeared in some copies of the September 5th issue of the Digest.

COMMISSION SETTLES ADMINISTRATIVE PROCEEDING AGAINST RICHARDT-ALYN & CO AND ITS PRINCIPALS, RICHARD AND ALAN FEINBERG

The Commission issued an Order Making Findings, Imposing Remedial Sanctions and Ordering Respondents to Cease And Desist. The Order alleges that during the period from in or about January 1994 to March 1995, in connection with certain OTC trades with four broker-dealers, information was provided that the transactions were completed at the national best bid or offer price (NBBO), and Respondents did not inform them that, on certain occasions, Richardt-Alyn purchased or sold the same stock on Selectnet at a price better than the NBBO. In this manner, Richardt-Alyn earned a total of \$17,477 in trading profits.

Administrative Law Judge Carol Fox Foelak issued an initial decision in this matter dated September 30, 1999. Subsequently, both sides filed Petitions for Review before the Commission. The Commission's Order sets aside the initial decision; censures the Respondents and orders them to cease and desist from violating Section 17(a)(2) and (3) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 17(a) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and Rule 17a-3 thereunder; orders Richardt-Alyn to comply with an undertaking to pay \$17,477; and orders Richard and Alan Feinberg each to pay a civil money penalty in the amount of \$5,000. INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

THE EQUITABLE LIFE ASSURANCE SOCIETY OF THE UNITED STATES, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 26(b) of the Investment Company Act to The Equitable Life Assurance Society of the United States (Equitable), Separate Account No. 301 of Equitable, Separate Account No. 45 of Equitable, Separate Account No. 49 of Equitable, and Separate Account FP of Equitable (collectively, Applicants) approving the substitution of securities issued by the EQ Advisors Trust's Alliance Equity Index Portfolio for securities issued by the EQ Advisors Trust's BT Equity 500 Index Portfolio and currently held by those unit investment trusts. The order also exempts Applicants

pursuant to 17(b) of the Act from Section 17(a) of the Act to the extent necessary to permit certain in-kind redemptions of portfolio securities in connection with the substitution and the consolidation of certain subaccounts by certain of those unit investment trusts following the substitution. PROVIDENT MUTUAL LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY, ET AL.

An order has been issued pursuant to Section 6(c) of the Investment Company Act granting exemptive relief from Sections 2(a)(32), 22(c) and 27(i)(2)(A) of the Act and Rule 22c-1 thereunder to Provident Mutual Life Insurance Company, Provident Mutual Variable Annuity Separate Account, Providentmutual Life and Annuity Company of America, Providentmutual Variable Annuity Separate Account, and 1717 Capital Management Company to permit the recapture of credits applied to purchase payments made under certain variable annuity contracts. FIRST AMERICAN INVESTMENT FUNDS, INC. AND U.S. BANK NATIONAL ASSOCIATION

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 10, 2000, to request a hearing on an application filed by First American Investment Funds, Inc. and U.S. Bank National Association for an order exempting applicants from Section 17(a) of the Investment Company Act. The order would permit a series of a registered open-end management investment company to acquire all of the assets, subject to the liabilities, of another series of the investment company. Because of certain affiliations, applicants may not rely on Rule 17a-8 under the Act. (Rel. IC-24645 – September 19)

SEASONS SERIES TRUST, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until October 16, 2000, to request a hearing on an application filed by Seasons Series Trust, et al. for an order exempting applicants from Sections 12(d)(1)(A) and (B) of the Investment Company Act and from Section 17(a) of the Act. The order would permit certain registered unit investment trusts or open-end management investment companies to acquire shares of registered open-end management investment companies both within and outside the same group of investment companies. (Rel. IC-24646 – September 19)

An order has been issued granting the application of the American Stock Exchange to strike from listing and registration Integrated Transportation Network Group Inc., Common Stock, \$.01 par value. (Rel. 34-43297)
