MEMORIAL SERVICE FOR FORMER COMMISSIONER PAUL CAREY

Securities and Exchange Commission Acting Chairman Laura S. Unger announced today that the SEC will host a memorial service for former Commissioner Paul R. STEVE CRIMMINS, DEPUTY CHIEF LITIGATION COUNSEL IN THE DIVISION OF ENFORCEMENT, LEAVES COMMISSION AFTER FOURTEEN YEARS OF SERVICE

Stephen J. Crimmins, Deputy Chief Litigation Counsel in the Division of Enforcement of the Securities and Exchange Commission, departed the Commission on Friday, July 13, 2001, after fourteen years of service to become a partner in the securities litigation practice group of Holland & Knight LLP in Washington, D.C., and New York City.

Mr. Crimmins, 52, became Deputy Chief Litigation Counsel in 1993, after serving for six years as a trial attorney in the Division of Enforcement. During that time, he co-managed the Division's Trial Unit over a period of tremendous growth and change, and served as one of the Division's senior executives. He litigated and tried numerous cases charging fraud and other violations of the federal securities laws, and played a key role in the Commission's enforcement actions against a number of well-known entities, including Blinder Robinson & Co., Thomas James Associates, Prudential Securities Incorporated, BT Securities Corporation, and KPMG LLP.

Richard H. Walker, the SEC's outgoing Director of Enforcement, said, "Steve has been an Enforcement Division treasure for many years. He has litigated many significant Commission actions and provided a steady hand in helping to oversee the Division's litigation program. His good cheer, dedication, and deep knowledge have made him an invaluable resource and a beloved figure throughout all of the SEC's divisions and regional offices. He will be greatly missed."

The SEC Enforcement Division's Chief Litigation Counsel, David L. Kornblau, added, "Legions of SEC litigators and staff attorneys have long turned to Steve for insightful, creative, practical, and prompt advice. His integrity, decency, and selfless devotion to public service are legendary. I am grateful to him for his friendship and superb counsel, particularly during the last seven months when he has been my partner in leading the Trial Unit."

Mr. Crimmins said, "It has been a privilege to work with the exceptional people who make up the SEC's Enforcement Division. Their enthusiasm, expertise, and dedication to protecting investors have made this job truly a joy for all of my fourteen years here. Likewise, the new initiatives launched by Commission and Division leadership during my tenure have been exciting and professionally satisfying for me."

Before joining the Commission, Mr. Crimmins practiced law with Lord, Day & Lord in New York City and with Bingham, Dana & Gould in Boston. He received his law degree from Columbia University in 1973, and was Articles Editor of the Columbia Journal of Law & Social Problems. A native of Brooklyn, he received his undergraduate degree from Fordham University in 1970. (Press Rel. 2001-71)

ENFORCEMENT PROCEEDINGS

SEC OBTAINS FINAL JUDGMENT AGAINST PAUL MONTLE INCLUDING A FIVE-YEAR BAR ON MONTLE SERVING AS AN OFFICER OR DIRECTOR OF ANY PUBLIC COMPANY, OVER \$360,000 IN DISGORGEMENT AND INTEREST, AND A \$50,000 CIVIL PENALTY

The Commission announced that on July 12, the Honorable Milton Pollack of the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York entered a final judgment against Paul J. Montle (Montle). Following a four-day bench trial in May of this year, the Court entered a judgment against Montle on all of the Commission's claims against him.

The judgment

- permanently enjoins Montle from future violations of Section 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933 and Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934; Section 13(b)(5) of the Exchange Act; and Section 13(b)(2) of the Exchange Act;
- bars Montle for five years from serving as an officer or director of any public company;
- bars Montle for five years from participating in the sale of securities under Regulations S and D of the Securities Act;

- orders Montle to disgorge his ill-gotten gains of \$187,459.25 and prejudgment interest of \$177,633; and
- orders Montle to pay a \$50,000 civil penalty.

The Court found that Montle's "violations involving fraud and deceit were numerous and ongoing," and that his "actions were knowing departures from the securities laws." The Court further found that Montle's testimony in his own defense "was without even the semblance of credibility" and "was infected by the same variety of distortion and outright falsehood that accompanied his deceptions in the arena of publicly held companies," and concluded that "there is strong evidence that [Montle] is likely to violate the securities laws in the future."

The Court further found that:

- Montle violated the federal securities laws regarding three public companies: Viral Testing Systems Corporation (VTS), which marketed an HIV diagnostic test called "Fluorognost"; Lone Star Casino Corporation (Lone Star), which sought to own and operate gambling casinos; and RMS Titanic, Inc. (Titanic), which attempted to salvage artifacts from the sunken Titanic ocean liner.
- As CEO and a director of VTS, Montle made material misrepresentations in two trade publications and a VTS press release regarding VTS's revenues and projected revenues and related matters. For example, in an article that appeared in Today's Investor, Montle overstated VTS Fluorognost revenues by more than double, projected grossly overstated future revenues, and falsely claimed that the American Red Cross had "endorsed" Fluorognost.
- As Chairman and CEO of Lone Star, Montle intentionally omitted from numerous public SEC filings that Lone Star had sold more than a million shares of its stock to foreign investors, thus concealing significant dilution. Montle also attempted to cover up this fraud by falsely altering Lone Star's Board of Director's minutes, omitting the stock sales from Lone Star's books and records, failing to disclose the sales to Lone Star's securities counsel, and creating sham stock purchase agreements.
- Montle also orchestrated a scheme to manipulate the stock of Titanic, causing it to open at an arbitrarily high price of \$5 per share, climb to \$11 within two months, and subsequently fall below \$5. Through this scheme, Montle obtained ill-gotten gains totaling at least \$187,459.25.

Montle, age 53, resides in Massachusetts. [SEC v. Paul J. Montle, et al., 98 Civ. 3446 (MP), U.S.D.C., S.D.N.Y.] (LR-17066)

SEC BRINGS CHARGES AGAINST FRAUDULENT OFFERING OF STOCK IN PURPORTED WORKERS' COMPENSATION INSURANCE VENTURE

On July 13, the Commission announced that it charged William L. Brotherton (Brotherton), an unlicensed Colorado chiropractor, and the company he founded, International Business Consortium, Inc. (IBC), with perpetrating a fraudulent, unregistered offering of \$20 million in IBC stock over the internet. The complaint alleges that the offering began early in 2001 and continued into July, and that the defendants raised over \$300,000 from selling IBC stock to at least 180 investors. IBC holds itself out as a promising start-up preparing to offer discount workers' compensation insurance when, according to the allegations, it has deceived investors about, among other things, its true state of development and operations. The Commission alleges that IBC and Brotherton have misappropriated at least 25% of the offering proceeds for the personal benefit of Brotherton and certain of his relatives. The complaint, filed in the United States District Court for the District of Colorado, charges the defendants with violating Sections 5(a), 5(c) and 17(a) of the Securities Act of 1933, Section 10(b) of the Securities Exchange Act of 1934, and Rule 10b-5 thereunder.

The complaint names as defendants:

- **Brotherton**, age 60, who resides in Fort Collins, Colorado. Brotherton is, and was at the time of the events alleged herein, IBC's president, vice-president, secretary, treasurer and sole director.
- **IBC**, which is a Colorado corporation whose sole business address is Brotherton's residence. IBC is not and never has been registered with the Commission in any capacity.

Also on Friday, the Commission moved for an order granting emergency relief to halt the fraud including orders (a) temporarily restraining, and preliminarily enjoining, defendants from violating Sections 5(a), 5(c) and 17(a) of the Securities Act, and Sections 10(b) of the Exchange Act and Rule 10b-5 thereunder; (b) freezing defendants' assets; (c) directing defendants to provide verified accountings; and (d) prohibiting the destruction, alteration, or concealment of documents; and (e) providing that the Commission may take expedited discovery. The litigation is pending. [SEC v. William L. Brotherton and International Business Consortium, Inc., Civil Action No. 01-WM-1340, USDC D. Colo.] (LR-17067)

INVESTMENT COMPANY ACT RELEASES

MORGAN GRENFELL INVESTMENT TRUST, ET AL.

A notice has been issued giving interested persons until August 7, 2001, to request a hearing on an application filed by Morgan Grenfell Investment Trust, et al. for an order exempting applicants from Section 12(d)(1)(G)(i)(II) of the Investment Company Act. The order would permit funds of funds relying on Section 12(d)(1)(G) of the Act to invest in securities and other instruments. (Rel. IC-25063 – July 13)

A proposed rule change (SR-PCX-2001-14) and Amendment Nos. 1 and 2 thereto filed by the Pacific Exchange relating to generic listing standards applicable to the listing and trading of Investment Company Units and Portfolio Depositary Receipts pursuant to Rule 19b-4(e) under the Securities Exchange Act has become effective, as amended, under Section 19(b)(2) of the Securities Exchange Act.
