

Memorandum of Interview of [Redacted] New York Examiner

On August 12, 2009, I interviewed SEC Supervisor Securities Compliance Examiner [Redacted] New York Examiner by telephone.

[Redacted] New York Examiner started at the SEC as an examiner in [Redacted] Personal Privacy. He was an examiner on the 1990 NERO BD exam of BMIS. He recalled examiners Demetrios Vasilakis and Kenneth Liebl were also on the examination. He believed the examination was a routine examination consisting of checking BMIS' records, ledgers and sales practices on a regular three-year cycle. He did not recall who supervised the examination and did not recall whom he met with at Madoff. He did not believe that they found any violations or regulatory issues during the BMIS examination.

[Redacted] New York Examiner had no idea what Madoff's reputation was in 1990.
