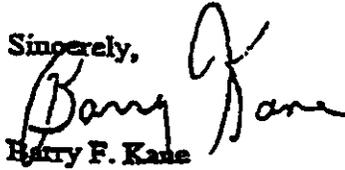
Re: Rule 15(b)7-3P Certificate of FSC Securities Corporation and Affiliates

Dear Sir or Madam:

Pursuant to Rule 15(b)7-3P, we hereby certify that:

- (i) Our broker/dealer is in the process of remediating its material Year 2000 problem;
- (ii) Our broker/dealer has scheduled testing of its affected mission critical systems to verify that the material Year 2000 problem has been remediated. Unit testing has taken place from March 1998 to date, and additional testing will continue to occur and be completed by October 1, 1999;
- (iii) By November 1, 1999, we anticipate completing any additional remediation of the material Year 2000 problem in our mission critical systems that will therefore be operationally capable; and
- (iv) Based on inquiries and to the best of my knowledge, our firm does not anticipate that the existence of the material Year 2000 problem and our mission critical systems will impair our ability to ensure prompt and accurate processing of securities transactions, including order entry, execution, comparison, allocation, clearance and settlement of securities transactions, the maintenance of customer accounts, or the delivery of funds and securities; and we anticipate that the enumerated remediation steps will result in remedying the material Year 2000 problem on or before November 15, 1999.
