Eligible New Listings and Eligible Transfer Companies:

Tier A: For Eligible New Listings and Eligible Transfer Companies that list on the Exchange on or after January 11, 2021 with a global market value of \$400 million or more, in each case calculated as of the date of listing on the Exchange, the Exchange offers market surveillance, market analytics, web-hosting, webcasting, and news distribution products and services for a period of 48 calendar months. Eligible New Listings and Eligible Transfer Companies that listed on the Exchange prior to January 11, 2021 with a global market value of \$400 million or more, in each case calculated as of the date of listing on the Exchange, continue to be entitled to such services for a period of 24 months.

Tier B: For Eligible New Listings and Eligible Transfer Companies that list on the Exchange on or after January 11, 2021 with a global market value of less than \$400 million, in each case calculated as of the date of listing on the Exchange, the Exchange offers Web-hosting, market analytics, web-casting, and news distribution products and services for a period of 48 calendar months. Eligible New Listings and Eligible Transfer Companies that listed on the Exchange prior to January 11, 2021 with a global market value of \$400 million or more, in each case calculated as of the date of listing on the Exchange, continue to be entitled to such services for a period of 24 months.

Global market value for an Eligible New Listing and Eligible Transfer Company is based on the public offering price; if there is no public offering in connection with listing on the Exchange, then the Exchange shall determine the issuer's global market value at the time of listing for purposes of determining whether the issuer qualifies for Tier A or B.

At the conclusion of the 48-month period (or 24-month period where applicable), Tier A and Tier B issuers receive Tier One or Tier Two products and services if they qualify based on total shares of common stock (for a U.S. issuer) or equity security (for a non-U.S. issuer) issued and outstanding as described above under the heading "Eligible Current Listings."
