Rule 1.1E. Definitions

Exchange Traded Product and UTP Exchange Traded Product

(bbb) The term “Exchange Traded Product” means a security that meets the definition of “derivative securities product” in Rule 19b-4(e) under the Securities Exchange Act of 1934 and a “UTP Exchange Traded Product” means [an] one of the following Exchange Traded Products that trades on the Exchange pursuant to unlisted trading privileges[.];

- Equity Index-Linked Securities,
- Commodity-Linked Securities,
