.10 Change of DMM Unit upon Request of Company

(a) A listed company may file with the Corporate Secretary of the Exchange a written notice (the "Issuer Notice"), signed by a senior official with the rank of Corporate Secretary or higher of the company[s chief executive officer], that it wishes to request a change of DMM Unit. The Issuer Notice shall indicate the specific issues prompting this request. The Corporate Secretary shall provide copies of the Issuer Notice to the DMM Unit currently registered in the security, the Exchange's Global Corporate Client Group, and NYSE Regulation, Inc. ("NYSER"). After said written notice and completion of NYSER's review, the security shall be put up for allocation pursuant to Rule 103B - Equities, subject to the provisions of subparagraph (b) below.
