From 1974 to 1990, Mr. Goelzer was on the staff of the Securities and Exchange Commission, and from 1983 to 1990, he served as Commission's General Counsel. From 1990 until joining the Board, Mr. Goelzer was a partner in the Washington, D.C. office of the law firm of Baker & McKenzie. Mr. Goelzer has also served as an adjunct faculty member at the Georgetown University Law Center.

Mr. Goelzer is also a Certified Public Accountant. From 1969 to 1970, he worked as an auditor in the Milwaukee, Wisconsin office of Deloitte & Touche.
